

## **CDBG** Projects

This report provides an overview and progress report for each project funded through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant Program that is administered by the City of Myrtle Beach.



### **Housing Rehabilitation**

**Project:** provide forgivable loans/grants to low to moderate income homeowners for essential or emergency housing repair needs.

FY 2015-16 & FY 2016-17 Budgets: \$ 514,632.08

Amount spent to date: \$411,693.00

#### **Activities:**

- A total of 20 projects completed from July 1, 2015 June 30, 2018.
- Average rehab cost: \$25,731.60.
- Four applicants denied. Income exceeded guidelines requirement.
- Eight (8) projects currently planned to be completed for 2018-19 program year utilizing remaining of 2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18 funds along with FY 2018-19 funding of \$311,184.

# Community Development Charlie's Place

**Project:** rehabilitate the two vacant, dilapidated structures and create a site that is useable for the public. The rehabilitation project seeks to retain and recapture the historic, character-defining exterior feature of the former residential building while providing a compatible new use, ADA access and new rear addition that appears to be compatible with the character, massing, scale and features of the historic buildings on the site.


