Community Development Block Grants Programs Progress Report



CDBG Projects

This report provides an overview and progress report for each project funded through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant Program that is administered by the City of Myrtle Beach.



Housing Rehabilitation

- **Project:** provide forgivable loans/grants to low to moderate income homeowners for essential or emergency housing repair needs.
-
- **FY 2015-16 & FY 2016-17 Budgets:** \$ 514,632.08
 - **Amount spent to date:** \$411,693.00
 - **Activities:**
 - A total of 20 projects completed from July 1, 2015 - June 30, 2018.
 - Average rehab cost: \$25,731.60.
 - Four applicants denied. Income exceeded guidelines requirement.
 - Eight (8) projects currently planned to be completed for 2018-19 program year utilizing remaining of 2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18 funds along with FY 2018-19 funding of \$311,184.
