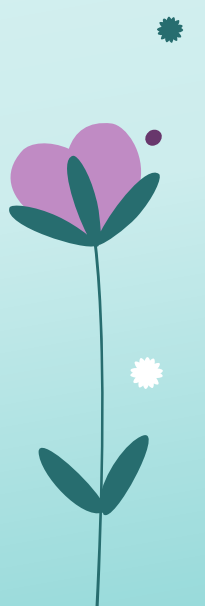
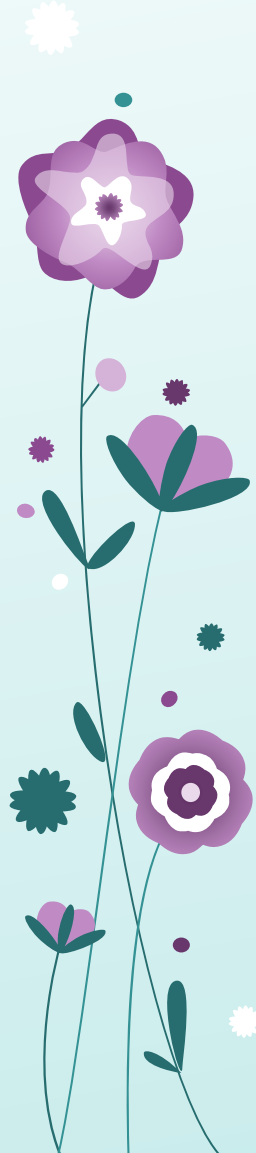

City Beautification Program



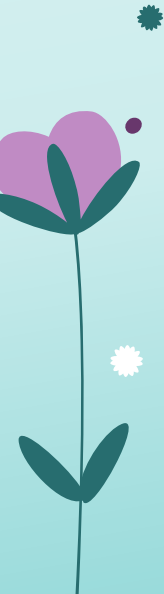
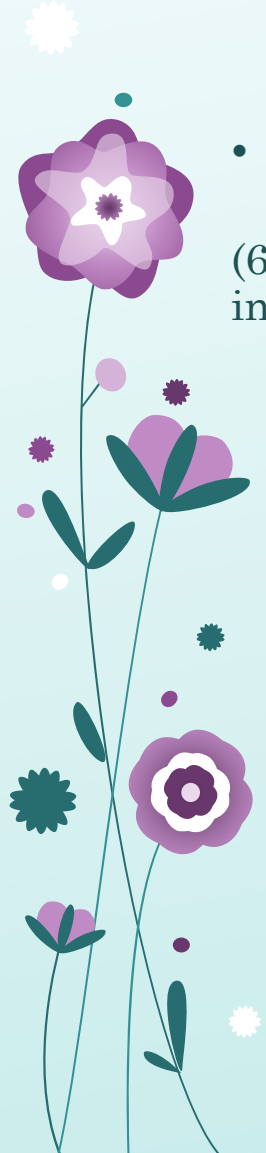
Purpose:

(6th Avenue S. to 29th Avenue N.; consider possibility of including 9th Avenue and Main Street)



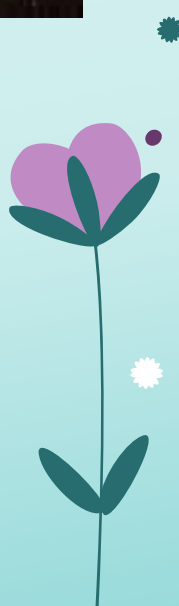
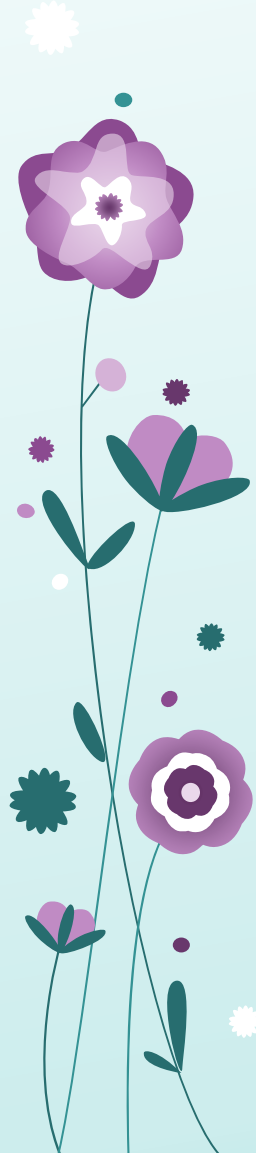
