Federal Updates

- April 16, 2020 Guidelines for Opening Up America Again: On Thursday, April 16, President Trump and the White House Coronavirus Task Force unveiled <u>new guidelines</u> (*download* <u>here</u>) for the reopening of America.
- **President Trump Signs H.R. 266 Paycheck Protection Program and Health Care Enhancement Act**: Friday, April 24, President Trump <u>signed the new legislation</u> into law to further assist American businesses, workers and healthcare providers. The legislation provides \$310 billion in additional funding for the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP), \$60 billion more for the Small Business Administration's (SBA) Disaster Loan Program, \$75 billion in funding for hospitals and healthcare providers, and \$25 billion to support our Nation's testing efforts. - Pandemic Unemployment Assistance available as of April 25, 2020 for those ineligible for unemployment benefits (i.e. gig workers, 1099 employees...). This includes the weekly benefit rate plus \$600/week from the CARES Act.
- Federal Pandemic Unemployment Compensation has been issued since April 12, 2020 for those receiving the weekly unemployment benefits plus \$600/week from the CARES Act.
