## DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS 100<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY

WHEREAS, Disabled American Veterans (DAV) was founded September 25, 1920, by World War I veterans and officially chartered by an Act of Congress on June 17, 1932; and

WHEREAS, In 2020, DAV celebrates 100 years of serving veterans of the Armed Forces, as well as their families, survivors and communities, by empowering veterans to lead lives of respect and dignity and assisting in their transition back to civilian life; and

WHEREAS, DAV accomplishes this by ensuring veterans and their families have access to the full range of benefits, by fighting for the interests of America's injured heroes and by educating the public about the needs of veterans; and

WHEREAS, DAV provides free, professional assistance to veterans and their families in obtaining benefits and services provided by the US Department of Veterans Affairs and other agencies; and

WHEREAS, DAV has fought tirelessly for equal access to critical VA caregiver benefits and services for severely disabled veterans of all generations, resulting in legislation to expand eligibility to those injured prior to September 11, 2001, as part of the VA Mission Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Myrtle Beach City Council hereby honors Disabled American Veterans on the occasion of the group's 100th anniversary and recognizes the unending commitment to ill and injured veterans of all generations and conflicts; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this community hereby applauds and appreciates the volunteer work of Mrs. Lynn Helms Prosser on behalf of our veterans in DAV Chapter 30 and in support of the local veterans community here in Horry County.
