3. **Just a reminder not to flush any wipes down your pipes!** With more people staying home and a shortage of standard toilet paper, please don't flush any alternatives you might be using. Toilet paper is designed to tear apart and move easily through the sewer system, but other items aren't. So-called "flushable wipes" can cause expensive repairs to your home's plumbing when they cause a clog, as well as to the city's and Grand Strand Water and Sewer Authority's pumps and systems.
4. **The online [E-Resources](#) webpage is available on the city's website.** City buildings are closed to the public, but we are working to provide online content for all ages. On the webpage, you'll find creative and educational options for you and your family to enjoy!
5. **Most activities for the next few weeks have been rescheduled, but we still maintain a comprehensive list on our [Events](#) webpage.** This file of city-related festivals, concerts, programs and more is updated weekly.

6. **Myrtle Beach city staff installed 170 hanging flower baskets along Ocean Boulevard, ready for when visitors can return, and it's the subject of our [Photos of the Week](#).** The baskets will stretch from 21st Avenue North to Sixth Avenue South, including parts of Mr. Joe White Avenue and Ninth Avenue North. The colorful spring flowers were ordered well before COVID-19 became an issue and were just delivered this week. This is the second year that we've installed hanging flower baskets along the boulevard to brighten the scenery and give a warm welcome.

7. **Did you know...** That Myrtle Beach has a new listing on the National Register of Historic Places? The Sun Fun Motel, at 2305 Withers Drive, was listed in the National Register on March 12, 2020. Constructed from 1963 to 1964 during Myrtle Beach's "Golden Era" of tourism, the Sun Fun Motel is a two-story, L-shaped masonry and frame building at 23rd Avenue North. It is listed at the local level for architecture and its association with Myrtle Beach's burgeoning mid-century tourism industry. When it opened in June 1963, the motel was a single line of eight units and featured a pool. By January 1964, the two owners requested a building permit for six additional units to create an L-shaped motel. Since 1964, the motel has retained a high degree of architectural integrity. The motel's debut coincided with the city's annual Sun Fun Festival, linking the motel with the popular event that marked the beginning of the yearly tourism season. The building illustrates a more restrained Modern aesthetic and is one of the few unaltered structures from this period remaining in Myrtle Beach.
