1. Next week's [meeting schedule](#) and agendas are attached.
2. **Would you like to serve on a volunteer board, commission or committee for the City of Myrtle Beach?** Vacancies exist already or terms will expire in the next two months on the Tourism Committee (3 seats), the Cultural Arts Advisory Committee (2 seats), the Recreation Advisory Committee (2 seats), the Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee (4 seats) and the Seniors Advisory Committee (1 seat). City Council also has one appointment to make to the Grand Strand Humane Society Board of Directors. To be considered for one of these volunteer positions, submit a letter of interest and a brief biography or résumé to the City Clerk, P.O. Box 2468, Myrtle Beach, SC 29578, or bring it to City Hall, 937 Broadway Street, Myrtle Beach, SC 29577.
3. **Local artist Tommy Simpson is giving The Whaling Wall at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center a fresh new look.** Simpson is repainting the 25-year-old mural by Wyland, retaining 90 percent of its originality but adding a little bit of color, too. Ours is number 49 out of 100 such murals that Wyland painted around the world. As it was when Wyland first created the wall, watching Tommy Simpson at work is likely to be a spectator sport. The repainting is expected to take six or seven weeks.
4. **The Matt Hughes Skatepark behind Pepper Geddings Recreation Center is closed for reconstruction.** The park was created in 1998 and is in need of a modern design with updated jumps and ramps. The city has hired a contractor to build a concrete street-scape skatepark. Demolition is underway, with new construction expected to begin in a week or two. The project should be complete by late July.
