2. **South Ocean Boulevard will be closed to traffic tomorrow (Saturday, September 18) for the big South Atlantic Shrine Association parade.** The SASA parade starts at 9:00 a.m. at 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue South and travels down to Springmaid Boulevard. It should end by 2:00 p.m. Some of the side avenues also will be closed to traffic due to parade staging. Hotels, please remind guests to park their vehicles on the west side of Ocean Boulevard on Friday evening, if they need to leave during parade hours on Saturday. This is especially true for guests checking out Saturday morning.
3. **Looking ahead, South Carolina's Largest Garage Sale is next Saturday, September 25, at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center.** Search for treasures among 200-plus booths in the 100,000-square-foot Exhibit Hall. Sale hours are 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Admission is free; parking is just \$5.00 per car for the day. Last year's sale was cancelled due to COVID.
4. **Make plans to celebrate National Night Out on Tuesday, October 5.** This year's event will be celebrated in the neighborhoods, with picnics, cook-outs, parties and other fun activities between 3:00 and 8:00 p.m. Stay tuned for a list of locations and events once the Neighborhood Watches finalize their plans.

The Unity Memorial has a new home at Warbird Park, and that's the subject of our [Photos of the Week](#).** The Myrtle Beach community honored the sacrifice and heroism that followed the terrorist hijackings of September 11, 2001, with a remembrance ceremony at Warbird Park, the new location for the Unity Memorial. This summer, the memorial was moved from 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue North to Warbird Park, where it is more visible and under the city's care and maintenance. It features a steel beam from the North Tower of the World Trade Center, presented to Golf Holiday (Golf Tourism Solutions) and Myrtle Beach by a group of retired FDNY firefighters, who started the long-running FDNY 9-11 Memorial Golf Tournament here on the Grand Strand. Nearly 1,000 people were on hand last Saturday for the ceremony, which included a poem about the beam and its new home, written and read by Paul Hickey, retired FDNY. Thanks to all who attended and participated.
- 8. Did you know...** That local residents can play the city's Whispering Pines Golf Course for just \$35 per round, including cart? That's a very affordable and convenient golf outing. Better yet, the local rate is available to residents of Horry, Georgetown and Brunswick Counties! Atlantic Golf Management operates the course under contract from the City of Myrtle Beach. Whispering Pines hosted approximately 50,000 rounds of golf last year.
