On Tuesday, October 6, the mask photos will be posted to the [Myrtle Beach Police Department](#) Facebook page, and department staff will select the winners. First prize wins a RING doorbell system and gift bag; second and third prizes win gift bags. (Note that inappropriate designs will not be posted.)
4. **The deadline is 12:00 p.m., Monday, October 5, to enter the Seniors Advisory Committee art contest and perhaps win \$250.** The City of Myrtle Beach has received a

grant from the AARP Community Challenge to create and display bicycle and pedestrian safety messages at 10 key intersections throughout the city. The contest is for 10 illustrations that convey a Myrtle Beach-related message about bicycle or pedestrian safety, wayfinding or proper social distancing for walkers and bikers. The AARP grant involves two of the city's committees. The Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee will come up with the safety messages, while the Seniors Advisory Committee will sponsor the art contest and select the 10 winning artistic submissions. The safety messages and winning illustrations will be combined into vinyl wraps that will cover the large traffic signal control cabinets at the 10 intersections. Each winning artist whose work is selected will receive \$250 and the honor of having his or her artwork appear in public as part of the safety campaign. The Seniors Advisory Committee will meet at 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, to choose the winning artworks.
