- 3. New 2022 calendars are now available from the City of Myrtle Beach!** Pick up a free copy of this 12-by-18-inch calendar, while supplies last. It features photos of city places, people, activities and events. Stop by City Hall (937 Broadway Street), City Services Building (921 North Oak Street) or Chapin Memorial Library (400 14th Avenue North) to get your free calendar during regular business hours.
- 4. The City of Myrtle Beach understands that more solid waste is generated during the holiday period.** To accommodate our customers' needs, we will pick up extra bags of solid waste and trash placed beside your pelican during the period from Monday through Thursday, December 20-30. This exception is only valid during this two-week window. All other rules remain in place for solid waste service.
- 5. City offices and facilities will be closed on Friday, December 31, to observe the New Year's Day holiday.** The city's library and recreation facilities will close at 2:00 p.m. on Friday December 31, and remain closed on Saturday, January 1. *However, solid waste and recycling will be collected on the usual Monday-through-Thursday schedule.* Questions? - 6. In January, the City of Myrtle Beach will pick up natural Christmas trees at curbside to be recycled.** In late February, the trees will be ground by the Horry County Solid Waste Authority, and the resulting landscaping mulch will be available to the public for free. The annual effort helps give trees a second life and saves valuable space in the landfill. Place trees at the curb, but not in the travel lane, and don't cover any utility meters or boxes. Also, remember to remove all decorations and tree stands! No wreaths, please. If you don't want to wait for curbside pickup, you may take your tree to the city's drop-off point at the Jake Abraham Solid Waste Transfer Station, 3221 Mr. Joe White Avenue. Questions? - 7. The Myrtle Beach Fire Department offers both COVID-19 vaccines and booster shots at weekly clinics.** Staff administer the free vaccinations to registered individuals from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Thursdays at the City Services Building, 921 North Oak Street. To sign up, visit <https://bit.ly/MBFDVaccine>. Please arrive 30 minutes prior to your appointment to allow for pre-screening. For information, call 843-918-1255.

Kids of all ages shared smiles with the Grinch and Santa at the "Christmas on Carver Street" event, and that's the subject of our [Photos of the Week](#).** The Grinch was on his best behavior as Mr. Claus arrived on a red truck, provided by the Myrtle Beach Fire Department. Children received gifts and participated in the longtime tradition of sharing their holiday wishes with Santa Claus. The evening also featured snacks, an ugly sweater contest and holiday music. This new event was sponsored by Carver Street businesses and the Neighborhood Services Department.
- 10. Did you know...** That the City of Myrtle Beach received seven properties in the federal Lands-to-Parks program when the Myrtle Beach Air Force Base closed in 1993? The U.S. Interior Department transferred what we now know as Whispering Pines Golf Course,

General Robert H. Reed Recreation Center, Crabtree Memorial Gymnasium, the South Parks Maintenance Shop, Warbird Park, Barc Parc South and several athletic fields to the city for the public's use.
