WHEREAS, The Emergency Operations Center provided a wealth of information during three weeks of non-stop operations and connected those in need with available resources; and


WHEREAS, The Phone Bank provided an indispensable information line that answered 21,000 calls from residents, locals, visitors, business owners and members of the media;
