Compliance on the Beach

- ▶ From 3/1 to 3/28/2020, MBPD responded to or initiated 218 calls for service compared to 188 in 2019. These included public assistance, beach related calls, & drinking in public.
- ▶ Officers conducted education & sought voluntary compliance throughout March & will continue to do so moving forward.
- ▶ MBPD will continue to deploy officers to address areas of concern w/ the objective of keeping our community safe & healthy.



Compliance w/ Hotel & Amusement Restrictions

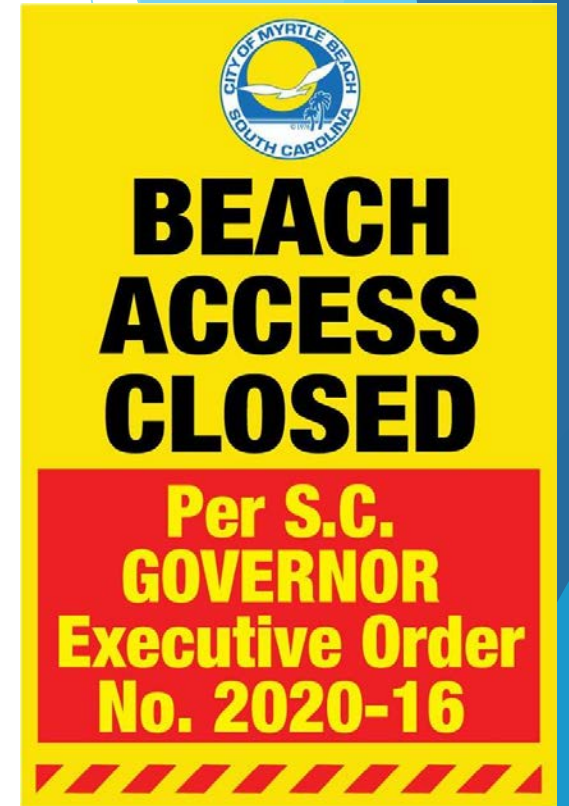
- ▶ Over the last several days, Officers conducted ~100 compliance checks & responded to ~30 complaints throughout the City specific to accommodations businesses.
- ▶ Voluntary compliance has been received at all businesses.
- ▶ Officers have also spot-checked all amusement businesses & received voluntary compliance.
- ▶ Our Regulatory Unit will continue to follow up w/ compliance checks & address areas of concerns.

S.C. Governor Executive Order 2020 - 16

- ▶ The Governor's Executive Order closes public accesses & parking at the accesses to beach & waterways throughout SC.
- ▶ The City has blocked all public accesses throughout the city.



- ▶ These areas are being monitored & addressed by MBPD.
- ▶ We continue to ask our community for voluntary compliance in all orders to promote public health.
