WHEREAS, Myrtle Beach Police Chief Amy Prock began as a patrol officer in 1996, rising through the ranks of the Police Department and learning every layer of law enforcement along the way; and

WHEREAS, Chief Prock demonstrated her ability to lead, from Neighborhood Watch groups to community-wide meetings, which resulted in her selection as Police Chief in 2017; and

WHEREAS, Chief Prock's accomplishments include the Real Time Crime Unit and a collaborative policing effort, resulting in a 15 percent reduction in violent crime in recent years; and

WHEREAS, Under her leadership, the Police Department has implemented a health and wellness program for officers, joined the National Integrated Ballistic Information Network and received a grant for the Acoustic Gunshot Detection System for the Myrtle Beach-area schools; and

WHEREAS, Chief Prock also is a statewide leader in the fight against opioid use and addiction, providing resources and solutions locally through "The Consolidated Effort," a team of treatment providers, first responders, faith-based leaders and others; and

WHEREAS, Chief Prock is a graduate of Radford University, Francis Marion University and the FBI National Academy, and is the 2023 municipality recipient of the Strom Thurmond Award for Excellence in Law Enforcement in recognition of her leadership and achievements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, That the Myrtle Beach City Council hereby commends and thanks Police Chief Amy Prock for 27 years of devoted service to this community and congratulates her for receiving the prestigious Strom Thurmond Award for Excellence in Law Enforcement as one of South Carolina's top law enforcement professionals.
