



RIDE III Project Status



Fred Nash Blvd Connection to Harrelson Blvd

- Preliminary Project Cost: \$19.3 MM
- Construction of a 3-lane road, including center turn lane to extend Fred Nash Blvd around to the end of the airport runway to provide a direct connection to Harrelson Blvd. Includes multimodal facilities.
- Currently in the right-of-way acquisition phase
- Proposed Construction Start Date: February 2023

Hwy 501 Realignment (Broadway St to 7th Avenue N)

- Preliminary Project Cost: \$13.9 MM
- Realign Hwy 501 at Broadway St intersection to connect to 7th Ave N at Oak St. Install sidewalks and intersection improvements on 7th Avenue N between Oak St and Kings Hwy.
- Currently in the right-of-way acquisition phase
- Proposed Construction Start Date: August 2023
