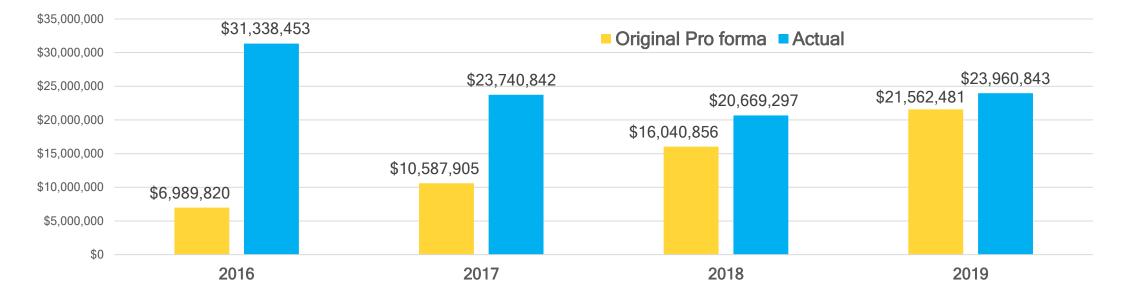

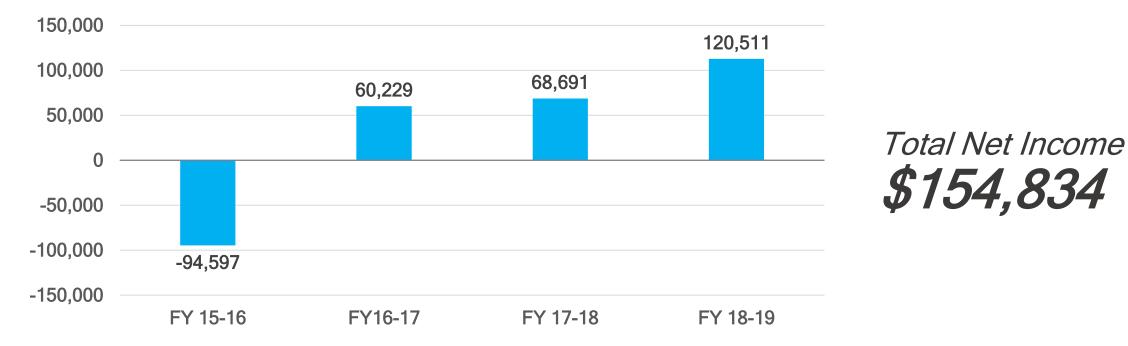

Facility Net Income



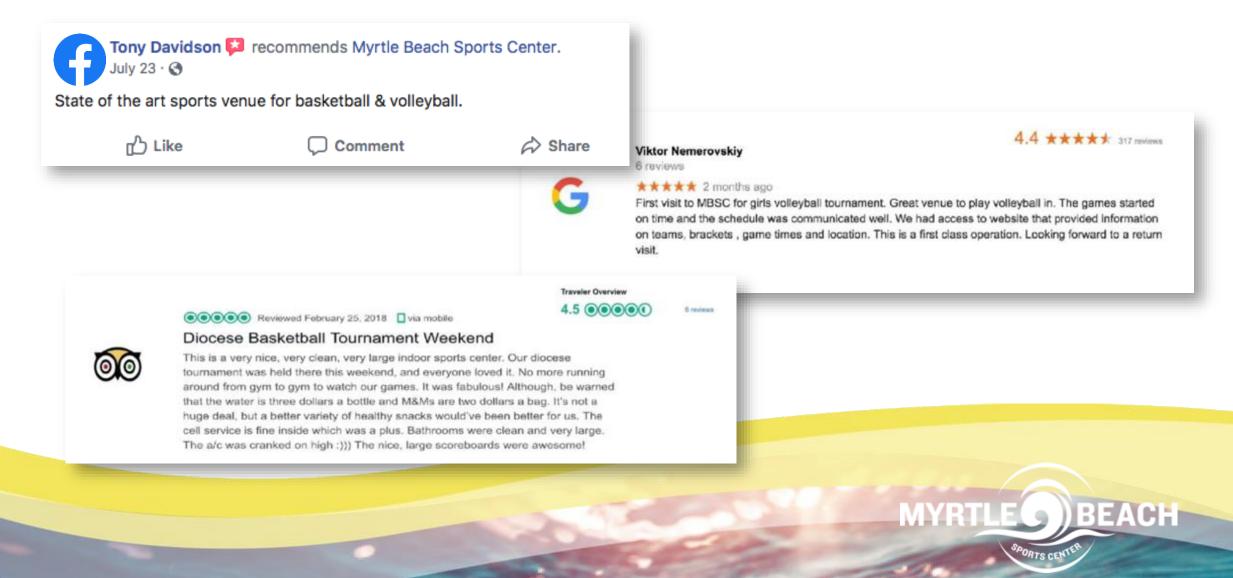

MBSC-SFM Extension Deal Points

No structural changes to current Agreement Extension treated as simple Amendment to current Agreement

- 5 Year Extension through June 30, 2025
- Base Fee: \$12,500/month (33% less than avg)
- Align Incentives with City objectives:
 - ✓ Bottom line improvement: 10% of improved Net Income over 2019
 - ✓ Increase Economic Impact: 20% of improved Tax Generation over 2019

(Applies to Sports Center only and not outdoor venues)

- \checkmark No change to other incentive: sponsorship, booking incentive.
- Personnel: health insurance "up to \$750/mo", comp approved annually through city budgeting process
