

RESOLUTION NO. 25-06

A RESOLUTION OF NEW HANOVER TOWNSHIP
APPROVING THE PLACEMENT OF A REFERENDUM ON
THE NOVEMBER 2006 ELECTION BALLOT TO ALLOW
VOTERS TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE EARNED INCOME
TAX SHOULD BE RAISED A CERTAIN MILLAGE IN
ORDER TO FUND ADDITIONAL OPEN SPACE
ACQUISITIONS IN NEW HANOVER TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, the New Hanover Township Board of Supervisors is desirous of preserving open space within New Hanover Township; and

WHEREAS, New Hanover Township has adopted and implemented an open space plan to provide for the conservation of open space to control growth and development within New Hanover Township; and

WHEREAS, New Hanover Township is desirous of obtaining additional funding necessary for the acquisition of open space in New Hanover Township; and

WHEREAS, New Hanover Township wishes for a referendum to be placed on the November 2006 election ballot to allow voters to determine if the New Hanover Township earned income tax should be raised a certain millage in order to fund open space acquisitions; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to 53 Pa. C.S. 8041, the New Hanover Township Board of Supervisors must adopt a Resolution signifying that New Hanover Township has determined that the referendum be placed on the election ballot and provide the Resolution to Montgomery County Voter Services; and


WHEREAS, the exact language of the referendum to be placed on the election ballot will be prepared and provided to Montgomery County Voter Services after the Board of Supervisors has adopted this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the New Hanover Township Board of Supervisors, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, as follows:


1. The Recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof.
2. A referendum shall be placed upon the November 2006 election ballot for New Hanover Township allowing voters to determine whether or not they want the Township earned income tax rate to be increased by .15% from to 1% to 1.15%.
3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.




