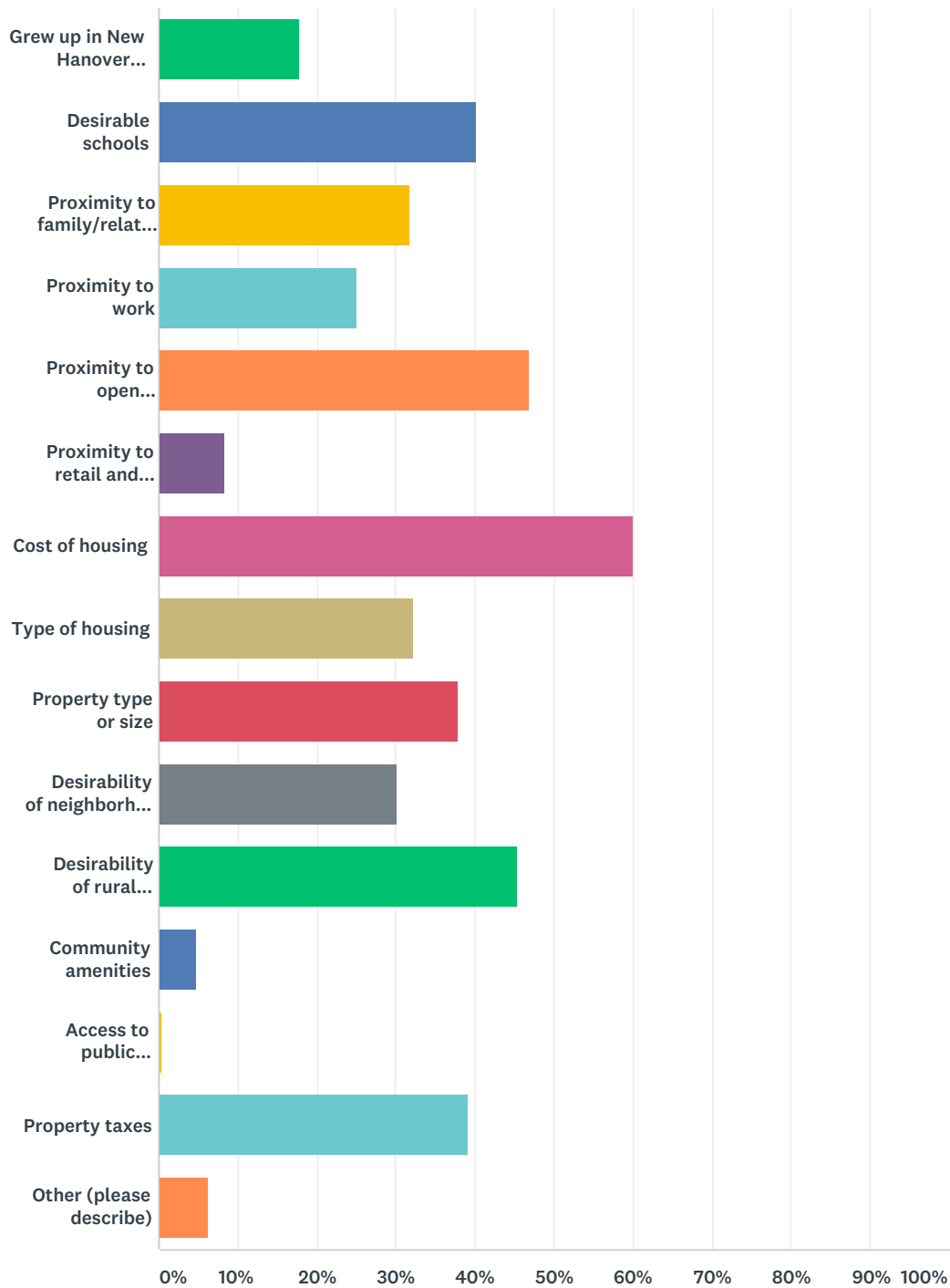


Q1 What influenced your decision to live in or relocate to the township? Select all that apply:

Q9 What impacts your visitation rate to New Hanover Township and regional parks and open space?

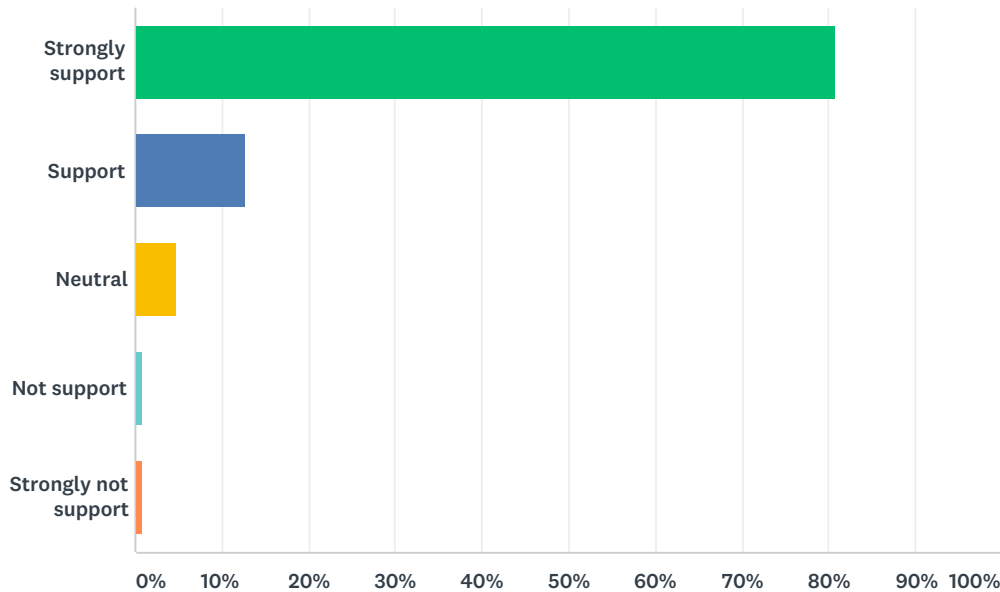

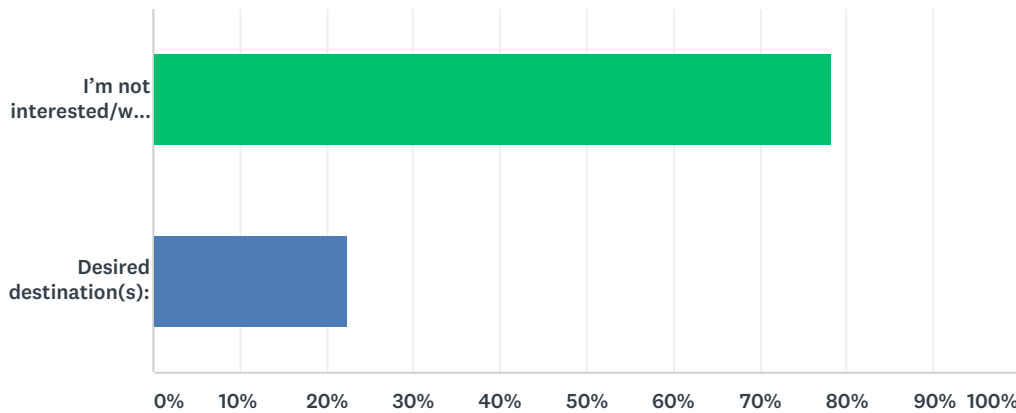

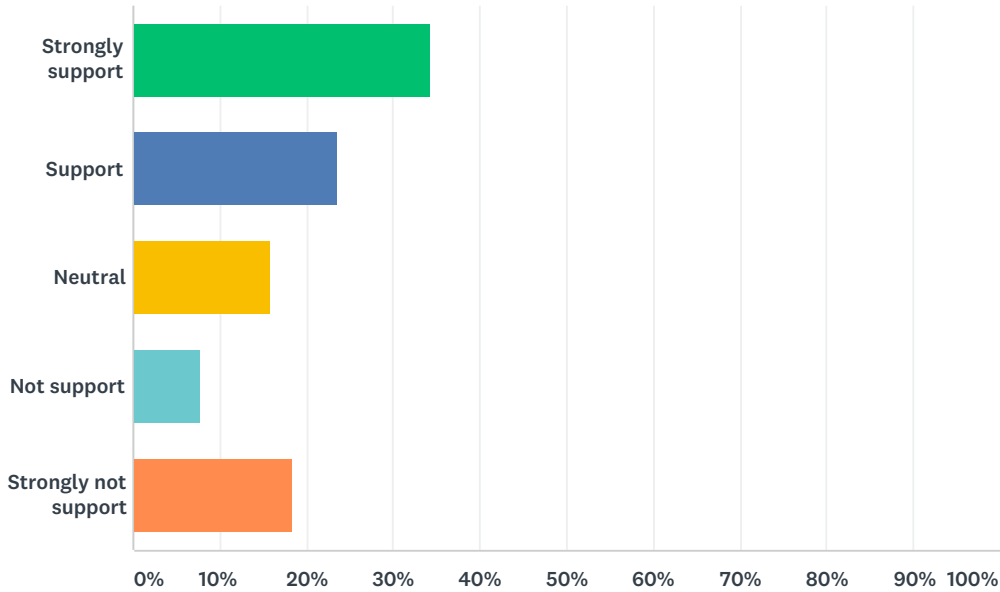

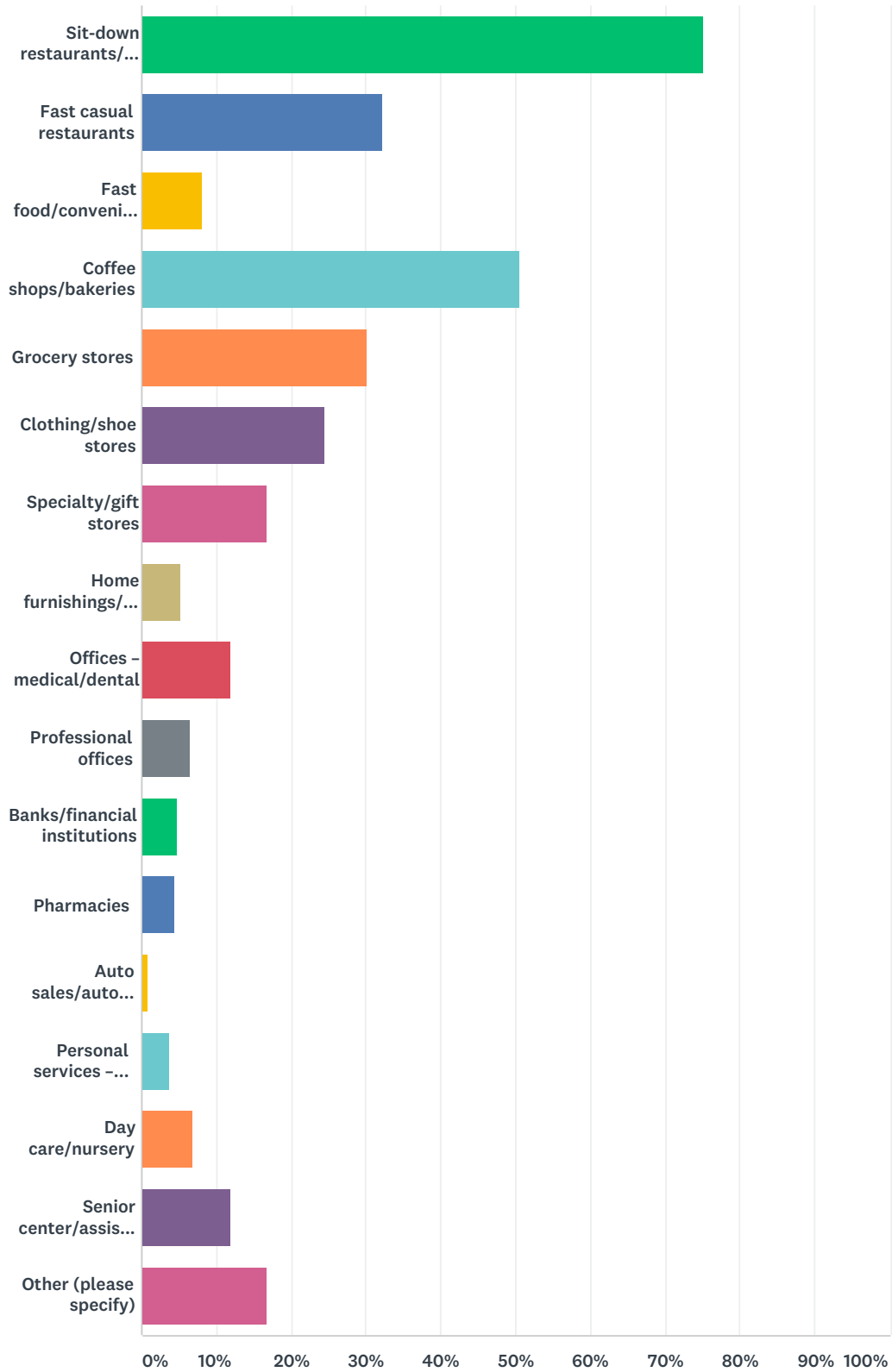

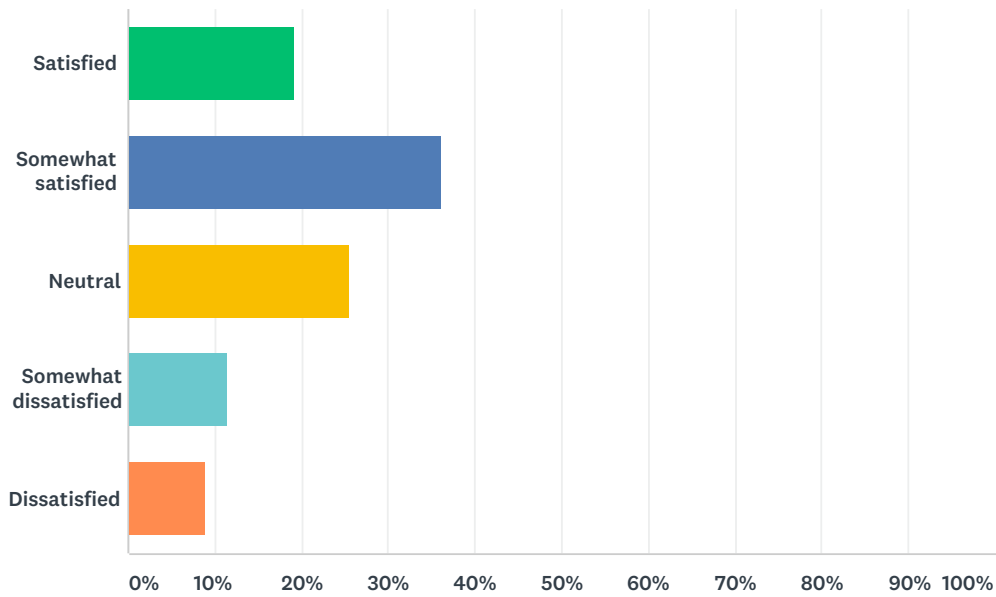

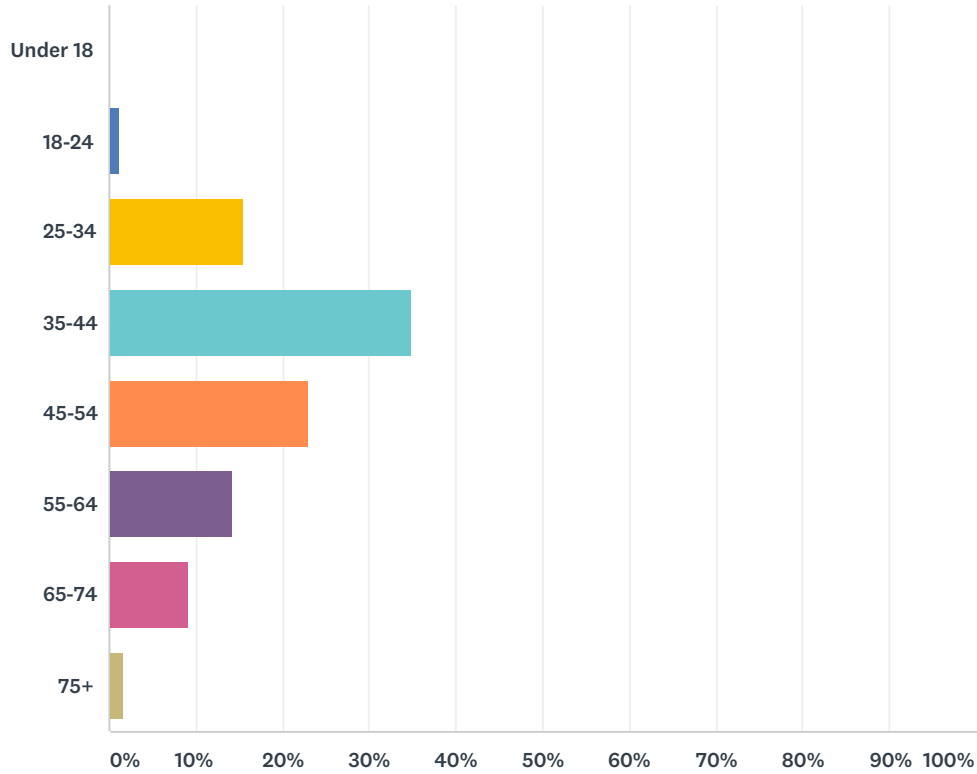

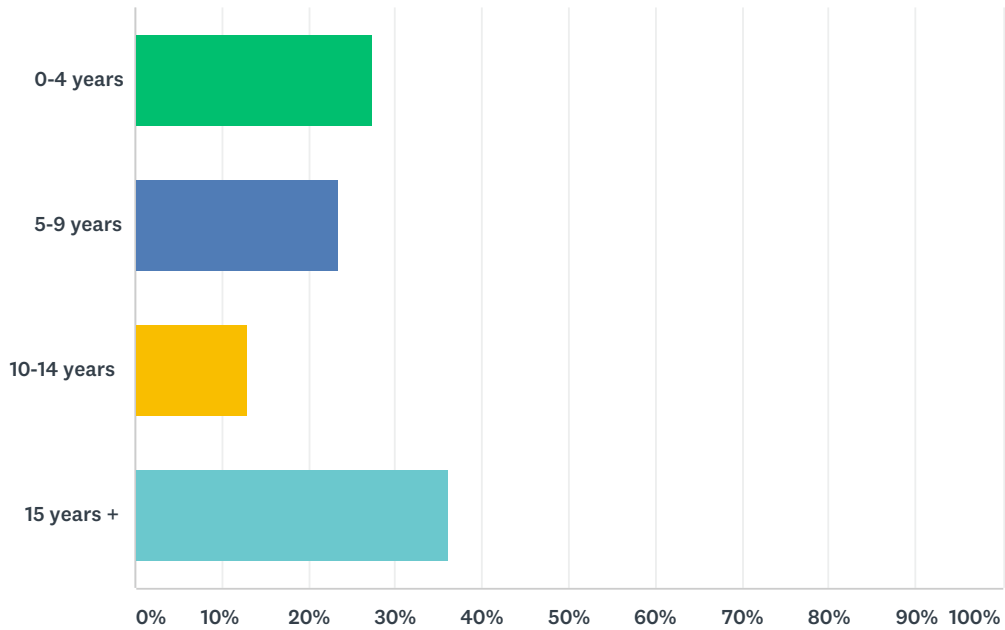

Q21 How long have you lived in New Hanover Township?

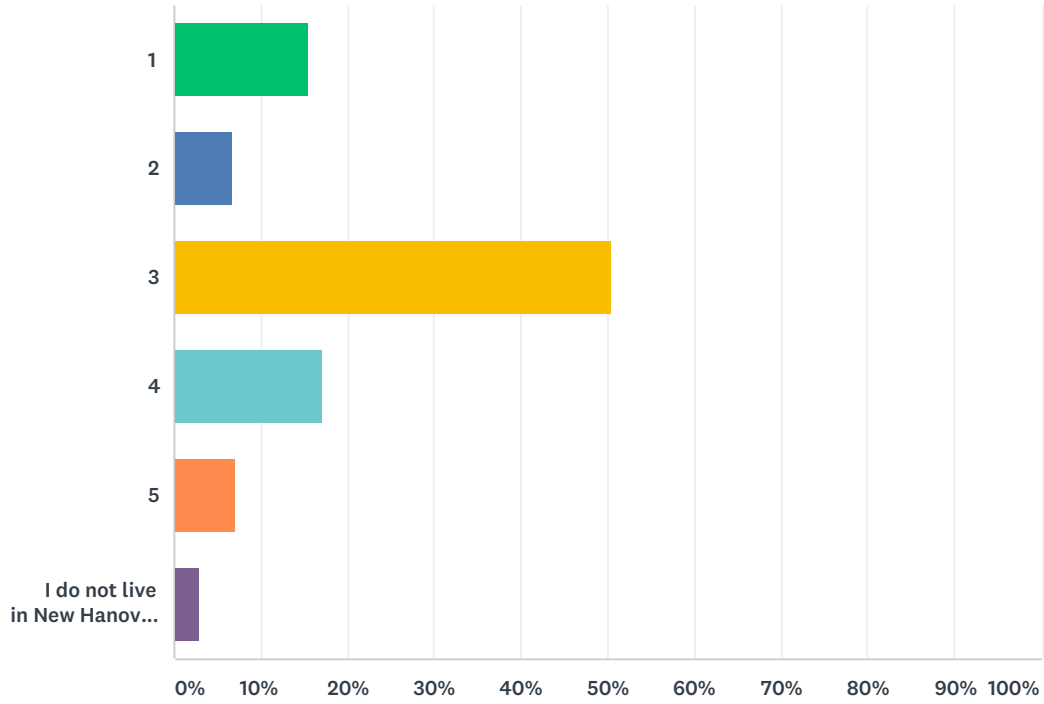
