NOTICE OF OBLIGATION TO CUT WEEDS

TO: The residents and property owners of the Charter Township of Niles, Berrien County, Michigan, and any other interested persons:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that in accordance with Michigan Public Act 359 of 1941, as amended, and Article III “Noxious Weeds” of the Niles Charter Township Code of Ordinances the owners/occupants of the improved properties within the Township shall **cut weeds, grass and uncontrolled plant growth to a height of not more than 10” by May 1, 2023.** The weeds, grass and uncontrolled plant growth must be maintained and/or cut to a height of not more than 10” throughout the balance of the year 2023 on all improved property within the Township.

In default whereof, **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Charter Township of Niles may enter the premises and cut the same as frequently as necessary during 2023 to comply with the foregoing regulations and may charge the cost thereof against the property owner and for collection may place the amount upon the next tax roll of the Charter Township as a tax lien against the offending premises.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any owner in default of the foregoing obligation to cut shall also be subject to a civil fine of up to \$500 for each violation. Such cutting obligation shall not apply to fields devoted to growing any small grain or vegetable crop.

This notice is published in accordance with said Public Act and Ordinance by order of the Niles Charter Township Board.
