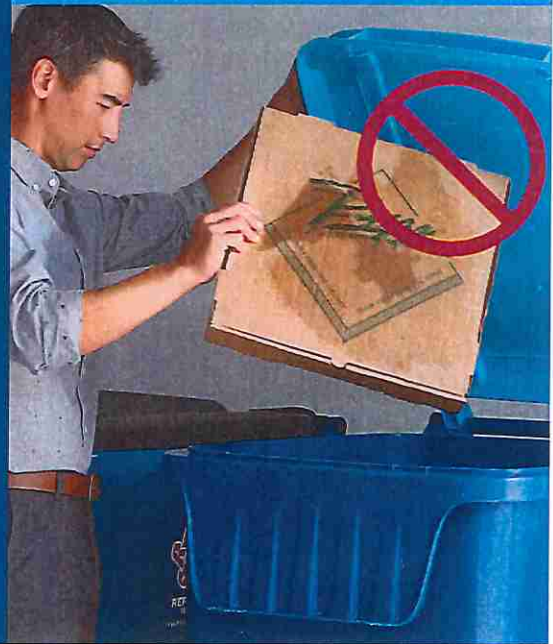

Republic Services of San Antonio is excited to provide trash and recycling collection for residents of the City of Pleasanton. We are excited to provide state of the art, automated garbage & recycling program for your community. Republic Services will provide a 96-gallon cart for Trash and Recycling. Please begin utilizing the Republic Services Blue carts on your first service day for trash and recycling.

What this Means for You

- Republic Services will be providing:
 - (1) 96-gallon cart for Trash to be serviced on
 - (1) 96-gallon cart for Recycle to be serviced EVERY OTHER WEDNESDAY

What you need to do in order to receive curbside collection.

Please have your Trash carts out by 7:00 a.m. to receive service. Please begin utilizing the carts immediately. We would like to encourage every resident to bag their trash prior to placing it in the waste receptacle. This helps prevent spillage during the service of your waste.

To avoid any interruption in service please follow directions below:

- To prevent potential damage to your property, set your cart **5 feet away from all objects** such as: cars, meters, poles, trees, power lines or other obstacles. **10 feet away from mailboxes.**
- Please do not overfill carts or place items on closed lid.
- Position the cart with the handles facing towards your home and wheels placed against the curb.
- Please trim trees so there is at least 14 feet of height clearance.
- Do not place liquids, dirt, rock, construction materials, hazardous materials, concrete or large metal parts into the garbage cart.
- **NO HOT ASHES!** Hot ashes will melt or destroy the cart.

Benefits of Bagging Your Trash

Republic Services, as a partner in the community, would like to encourage every resident to bag their trash prior to placing it in the waste receptacle. We have identified the important reasons for bagging your trash below.

- **On windy days, it protects the contents of the trash container from blowing out and scattering on the ground around the community**
- **It helps prevent spillage during the service of your waste**
- **It helps prevent spillage during transportation of waste to the disposal site**
- **Helps keep our environment, communities and roadways litter free**

The following is a list of household hazardous waste that should **NOT** be place in your trash:

- **Automotive products:** gasoline, motor oil, antifreeze, lead-acid batteries, brake fluid and transmission fluid.
- **Medical Waste:** biohazards, needles, syringes and lancets
- **Home improvement products:** varnish, stain, paint, paint thinner, paint stripper, caulk, adhesives.
- **Household cleaners:** drain opener, bleach and ammonia.
- **Pesticides:** insecticide and insect repellent, weed killer, rat and mouse poison.
- **Other:** Televisions, tires, pool chemicals, lighter fluid, hot coals from the BBQ or fireplace.
- **Propane tanks or compressed gas cylinders**

We are confident that this new automated system will be more efficient and environmentally friendly. As always, we appreciate your business and allowing us to be a partner in your community.

CURBSIDE BRUSH/BULKY COLLECTION PROCEDURES

- 3 annual yard waste/appliance/bulk clean up days, Spring, Summer and Fall (3 yards per residence), refer to City Hall for information
- Brush collection crews will be in your area to collect brush, bulky items, furniture, etc.
- Brush collection crews will pass by your street only once.
- Place all brush and bulky items separately at the front curb of residence to be serviced. Must be out by 7:00 AM on Monday of the week your block is scheduled to be picked up. Please note that commingled or mixed pile will not be serviced. Please keep brush and bulky items separate.
- Place all brush from fences, overhanging limbs, power lines, fire hydrants, gas and water meters, and vehicles. Such obstructions could prevent pick up.
- Regular garbage collection will take limbs if bundled together, measuring less than 4 ft and weighing less than 40 pounds.
- You may utilize out of cycle service for immediate bulk use at the rate of \$20.00 per yard. Out of cycle services are on the 3rd Saturday of every month. Must call the Customer Resource Center at 210-304-2700 to pay in schedule.



Important Notice **REPUBLIC SERVICES**

As Per Ordinance # 14-1117, 15-1155, 17-1197 & 17-1198

Effective October 1, 2014

"Republic Services, Inc is hereby granted the sole and exclusive franchise, license and privilege within the territorial jurisdiction of the City, and City owned property, and shall furnish all personnel, labor, equipment, trucks, and all other items to collect Waste and Recyclable Materials"

Any person OR company violating provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and can be fined up to \$2,000.00 per day the violation exists.
