



OPEN SWIM RULES

- Children 6 years and under must be directly supervised in the water by an adult, who must be within arm's length at all times.
- Children 12 years of age and under must have an adult within the facility at all times.
- Appropriate swim wear is required.
- Disposable swim diapers are not permitted. Please see Pool Attendant for approved swim diaper options.
- Outside food and drinks are not permitted in the facility. Water is the only permitted beverage.
- For safety reasons, outside flotation devices and toys are not allowed in the facility (with the exception of Coast Guard Approved PFDs).
- One whistle blast from the lifeguard, all patrons must STOP, LOOK and LISTEN to the guard
- LONG whistle blasts from the lifeguard, all patrons must EXIT the pool IMMEDIATELY
- Every swimmer must rinse off in the showers before entering the pool
- Running and horse play are prohibited on deck and in the pool.
- No hanging from Diving Board or Starting Blocks
- Feet First entries; NO Flips, NO Twists, NO Backward Entries.
- Only Coast Guard Approved PFDs are permitted during recreational swims. The use of these items is restricted to the shallow end of the pool.
- All personal belongings must be clear of the locker room at the end of the day.

For the safety and enjoyment of all participants, the lifeguard is in complete charge of the pool at all times and has final say in all rule interpretations. At anytime a guest may be removed from the pool for a any violations made above or from the discretion of the Recreation Authority staff.
