FULL TIME FIREFIGHTER/ EMT

The Town of Richmond has established full time Fire and EMS services Monday- Friday, 8am to 4pm. The Town of Richmond is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Full Time Firefighter/ EMT. This is a forty hour per week, benefitted position. Current members of the Richmond or West Stockbridge Fire Depts. meeting the qualifications will receive preference in hiring.

The minimum qualifications include a high school diploma or certificate of equivalency, current Massachusetts or National Emergency Medical Technician certification, current BLS CPR certification, and a valid drivers license. Fire experience with Firefighter 1/2 certification is preferred. Selected applicants not holding FF 1/2 will be sponsored through the MA DFS Academy in Springfield as a condition of employment.

All candidates must have general knowledge of the Massachusetts Office of Emergency Medical Services pre-hospital treatment protocols. Candidates are preferred to have a minimum of 2 years experience in the EMS field and 2 years fire experience, though all candidates will be considered. As a condition of hire, all candidates must currently be in good standing with their current medical control to be verified by our affiliate hospital.

Candidates must be motivated, be able to work as a part of a small crew, and carry out duties unsupervised. Candidates must be able to carry, balance and manipulate equipment/ patients up to 120 pounds.

Candidates will be expected to carry out firefighting and emergency medical operations as well as light custodial, grounds maintenance work, and other duties as assigned by the EMS Director or Fire Chief.

All candidates will be subject to a CORI check, drug screening, and pre-employment physical.

Initial interests will be assessed on **November 29th, 2022**, applications will be accepted until positions are filled.
