## LICENSE YOUR PETS

Obtain a license for any domestic animal over three months of age from City Hall Finance Department. A current certificate of rabies is required for registration.

- Until 7/15 Cat or dog not spayed/neutered license cost is \$7.00 on July 16 cost is \$9.00
- Each neutered or spayed dog or cat: \$5.00 on July 16 cost is \$7.00.
- Until 7/15: Each domestic animal not otherwise specified \$7.00 on July 16 cost is \$9.00.
- Senior Citizen Rate (65+) By July 15: \$4.00 Spayed/neutered cat or dog license cost and on July 16: \$6.00
- Replacement tag \$3.00
- Pound Fees: 1<sup>st</sup> day \$25.00; each additional day: \$10.00.
- Special Protection Constable Service-euthanasia: \$75.00

## **PET ZONE**

Perhaps you've notice these signs during your walks. Pet owners have the responsibility to care for their animals in a way that makes it a rewarding and loving experience for all.



Protect your pets by doing the following . . .

- Restrain your pet on a leash no longer than eight feet in length.
- Obtain a license for any domestic animal over three months of age from City Hall. Proof
  of rabies vaccination is required. The fee varies depending if the animal is spayed or
  neutered.
- Carry a litterbag with you whenever you are walking your dog. It is your responsibility to remove and dispose of any excreta deposited by your pet in a sanitary manner from the property of another, on public walks, streets, recreational areas or municipally owned property. Let's keep our neighborhoods beautiful as well as being environmentally safe.
- Limit your pets to no more than three.
