## Job Description

### Crossing Guard

#### General Purpose

Under the general supervision of the police department and chief crossing guard, assist children in crossing streets safely on a part time, seasonal basis while children attend school.

#### Examples of Duties

- As children arrive, takes them safely across the street, watching traffic closely and stopping cars if necessary.
- Process is repeated two times a day, when children travel to and from school.
- May act as a liaison between children, school safety patrol, and school principal or school safety patrol supervisor

#### Minimum Qualifications

- Must have High School diploma or its equivalent.
- Must be able to pass a standard hearing or eye test with correction.
- Must be physically able to stand for at least one hour at a time.
- Ability to use accurate judgement of traffic flow.
- Regular use of hand-held stop sign, reflector vest, cones, and whistle.

#### Work Environment

Regular and prompt attendance is essential; mental effort is required daily; job is performed outside and is subject to exposure to the elements: heat, cold, and wet conditions. The job involves walking and standing for long periods of time; constant seeing and hearing are required to fulfill job responsibilities; job is subject to exposure to environmental and/or physical hazards.
