4.1 CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING COMMENTS ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PUBLIC ACT 33 PUBLIC SAFETY SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT – CITY MANAGER / TREASURER.

COMMUNITY IMPACT/BACKGROUND: On 01/06/2020, City Council authorized and directed the City Manager to prepare cost estimates for hiring full-time firefighter paramedics at the Riverview Fire Dept. These cost estimates have been prepared and shared with the Ad Hoc Public Safety Committee and the City Council. It is anticipated that the special assessment levy will offset an expiring sewer debt judgment levy millage.

For purposes of funding these costs and expenses, the City Council has directed the City Manager to tentatively create a special assessment district pursuant to Michigan Public Act 33 of 1951, as amended, against which the estimated costs and expenses will be assessed. The tentative special assessment district will encompass all the lots and parcels of land located within the City of Riverview.

A public hearing must be held to allow comments on the estimated costs and the creation of the special assessment district. Notice of the public hearing was published in the News-Herald on 04/01/2020, and notices sent to all owners of lots and parcels located within the proposed special assessment district.

ACTION REQUESTED: City Council is requested to consider conducting the public hearing required under Public Act 33 of 1951, as amended, to receive comments on the creation of the proposed public safety special assessment district.
