COMMUNITY IMPACT/BACKGROUND: On 11/17/2020, The City Council authorized the seeking of bids for seeding and mulching. On 02/24/2021 notice of Invitation to Bid for seeding and mulching was posted on the City of Riverview website and on MITN, and mailed to (1) one vendor as provided on the vendor list. Bid response from three (3) vendors was opened on 03/11/2021. It is proposed that the bid be awarded to MDR Landfill Services out of Howell, Michigan for a three year term.

9.2 AWARD BID AND AUTHORIZE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENTS FOR TIRE SERVICES & REPAIR WITH POMP’S TIRE SERVICE, INC. FOR A THREE (3) YEAR TERM – LAND PRESERVE/DPW/GOLF COURSE.

COMMUNITY IMPACT/BACKGROUND: On 11/17/2020, The City Council authorized the seeking of bids for tire services and repair. On 02/24/2021 notice of Invitation to Bid for tire services and repair was post on the City of Riverview website and on MITN, and e-mails sent to 33 vendors and mailed to another 11 vendors as provided on the vendor list. Bid response from one (1) vendor was opened on 03/11/2021. It is proposed that the bid be awarded to Pomp’s Tire Service, Inc. out of Brownstown, Michigan for a three year term.

9.3 APPROVE BID AWARD AND AUTHORIZE EXECUTION OF THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT FOR ANALYTICAL & LEACHATE TESTING TO PACE ANALYTICAL, LLC, EUROFINS TESTAMERICA, RTI LABORATORIES, PARAGOL LABORATORIES, INC. AND TRACE ANALYTICAL LABORATORIES, INC. – LAND PRESERVE.

COMMUNITY IMPACT/BACKGROUND: On 03/16/2021, City Council authorized the solicitation process for Analytical Testing of Leachate, Ground and Surface Water. Notice of invitation to bid was posted 03/17/2021 on MITN, emailed to 146 participating vendors, the city of Riverview website and mailed to another 5 vendors as provided on the vendor list.

Bids from five (5) vendors were received and opened on 04/01/2021. Each bidder submitted pricing for three years. It is recommended that all vendors be awarded the bid due to time constraints and sensitivities of certain testing. The vendor utilized would depend on what type of tests were required, turnaround time, and sample transportation costs.

The Ad Hoc Land Preserve Committee concurred with this recommendation at their 05/10/2021 meeting.

Funds are available in accounts 596-526-816.200 and 596-526-816.665 of the current fiscal year. Executed copies of the standard agreement are on file in the Purchasing Department.

ACTION REQUESTED: City Council is requested to consider bid award to all five vendors, Pace Analytical, RTI Laboratories, Eurofins TestAmerica, Paragon Laboratories and Trace Analytical for analytical and leachate testing at Riverview Land Preserve.
