RESOLUTION #21-17

A RESOLUTION TO PLACE AN ADVISORY QUESTION ON THE NEXT AVAILABLE
ELECTION BALLOT REGARDING THE OPERATIONAL CAPACITY WITHIN THE EXISTING
RIVERVIEW LAND PRESERVE

- WHEREAS, Riverview City Council submitted an application dated January 4, 2021, and on file with the City Manager, to the Wayne County Facility Inclusion Committee (FIC), to include proposed additional operational capacity within the existing Riverview Land Preserve municipal solid waste landfill located at 20863 Grange Road, into the Wayne County Solid Waste Management Plan; and
- WHEREAS, such additional operational capacity is confined to the current state permitted and authorized limits of the land preserve; and
- WHEREAS, the FIC Committee reviewed the application and received public comments at a public hearing on August 2, 2021; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council desires to hear from the residents directly regarding their support for additional operational capacity at a City election; and
- WHEREAS, Section 2.2 and 2.3 of the Riverview City Charter provides that Council shall have power to exercise all municipal powers in the management and control of municipal property and in the administration of the municipal government,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following ballot shall be presented to the electorate on the next available election as follows:

"Shall the City of Riverview seek additional operating capacity within its current Land Preserve?"

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager, City Attorney and City Clerk shall arrange the ballot question to be presented at a special election if unable to place it on the general election ballot.
