Motion by Councilmember Gunaga, seconded by Councilmember Blanchette, that Authorization for the Clerk to give the **Second Reading**, by title only, of Proposed **Ordinance No. 736**, to Amend the Code of Ordinances for Traffic Control Orders 424 and 426 to Ratify and Approve the Traffic Control Orders and Adopt Section 66-36 accordingly, be Approved.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 736

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW TO AMEND SECTION 66-3 “TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDERS” TO RATIFY AND APPROVE TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER NUMBER 424; AND TO ADD SECTION 66-36 “APPLICATION TO RIVERVIEW LAND PRESERVE” TO ARTICLE II “ENFORCEMENT OF TRAFFIC ORDINANCES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY” OF CHAPTER 66 “TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES.”

THE CITY OF RIVERVIEW ORDAINS:

ARTICLE I. Section 66-3 is hereby amended to include Traffic Control Order Number 424 to hereafter read as follows:

Section 66-3. - Traffic control orders. All traffic-control devices and signs over which the City of Riverview retains jurisdiction, as listed in traffic-control orders through Traffic-Control Order Number 424, as filed with the City Clerk, are hereby adopted, approved and codified in conformance with Section 2.53 of the Uniform Traffic Code. This codification is made pursuant to MCL 117.5b, MSA 5.2084(2).

Further, Section 66-36 “Application to Riverview Land Preserve” is hereby added to Article II “Enforcement of Traffic Ordinances on Private Property” of Chapter 66 “Traffic and Vehicles” to hereafter read as follows:

Section 66-36. – Application to Riverview Land Preserve. The Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages and the Michigan Vehicle Code (MCL 257.1 et seq.), as adopted by the City, shall be applied to property owned by the Riverview Land Preserve and situated in the City in the same manner as other public property and shall be enforced by the City police in a similar manner, except as modified in this chapter.

ARTICLE II. Penalty: A person violating this ordinance shall be punished in accordance with Section 1-8 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Riverview, unless a different penalty is expressly provided in this ordinance.

ARTICLE III. Severability: Should any word, sentence, phrase or any portion of this Ordinance be held in a manner invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction or by any agency having authority to do so for any reason whatsoever, such holding shall be construed and limited to such word, sentence, phrase or any portion of the Ordinance held to be invalid and shall not be construed as affecting the validity of any remaining words, sentences, phrases or portions of the Ordinance.

ARTICLE IV. Conflicting Ordinances: All prior existing ordinances adopted by the City of Riverview

inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, hereby expressly repealed.

ARTICLE V. Codification; Scrivener's Errors:

- (a). Article I of this Ordinance shall be codified, and all other sections shall not be codified.
- (b). The sections, divisions and provisions of this Ordinance may be renumbered or re-lettered as deemed appropriate by the Code codifier.
- (c). Typographical errors and other matters of a similar nature that do not affect the intent of this Ordinance, as determined by the City Clerk and City Attorney, may be corrected with the endorsement of the City Manager, or designee, without the need for a public hearing.

ARTICLE VI. Reading and Publication: This Ordinance shall be given a first reading on September 19, 2022, shall be given a second reading on October 3, 2022, shall be adopted on October 3, 2022, and shall be published and become effective upon publication. The Clerk shall publish a summary of this ordinance and include in the publication notice that a true copy of the Ordinance can be inspected or obtained at the Clerk’s office.
