The next step is for City Council to waive Council Policy No. 1, Section 20(a)(8) and evaluate comments and questions on the proposed project plan, approve of the Riverview Land Preserve to apply for and submit the CWSRF application, adopt the final project planning document, and designate the Landfill Director as the authorized project representative.

ACTION REQUESTED: City Council is requested to waive Council Policy No.1, Section (20)(a)(8) and to consider adoption of a resolution approving the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Loan Application and adopting a final project planning document for wastewater system improvements and designating an authorized project representative.
