### 1,000 ft. Runway Extension

- Est. \$4.4 million

### Installation of Precision Approach Equipment - Est. \$1.2 million

### Parallel Taxiway Extension

- Est. \$10.8 million

### Cross Field Corporate Development

- Est. \$12.4 million

### Build-out of Current Terminal Area

- Est. \$9.6 million

### Land Acquisition Associated with Development Items (except current Terminal Build-out) - Est. \$4.8 million


## Airport Expansion Project Approach

1. Ramp Expansion to the North for  
Corporate Aircraft. Tie-Down /  
Transient Parking (0-1 years)

2. Expand Based Aircraft Facilities  
to the West until constrained by  
Terrain (1-5 Years)

3a. East Cross-Field Terminal  
Project (2-10 years)

3b. Extend Runway - Install Precision  
Approach (3-5 years)
