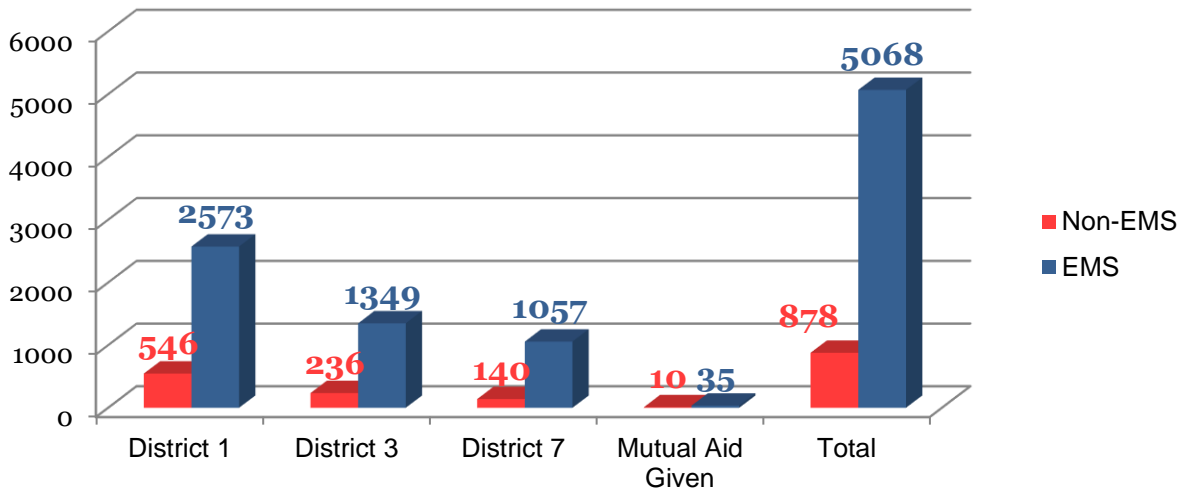

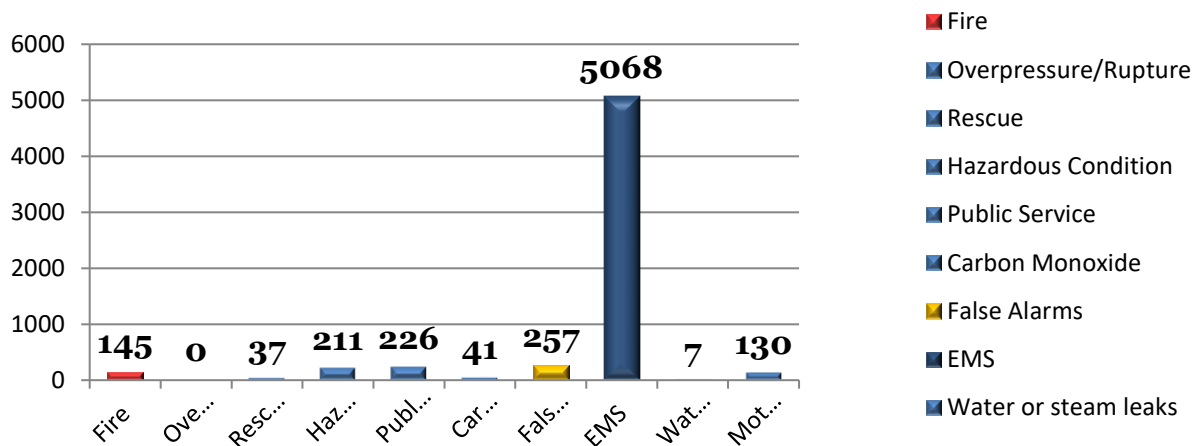


## Operational Reports



There were 5,946 reports generated in 2023. 52.5% of all reports were for District 1. Reports for District 3 and District 7 were 26.7% and 20.1% respectively. Mutual aid to other areas in Erie County accounted for .75% of all calls for service.

## Incident Type



EMS related calls continue to be the highest requested service at 85.2%. There were 145 fires reported in 2023. False alarms represented 4.3% of all emergent activity. There was an estimated \$981,700.00 in fire loss in 2023.

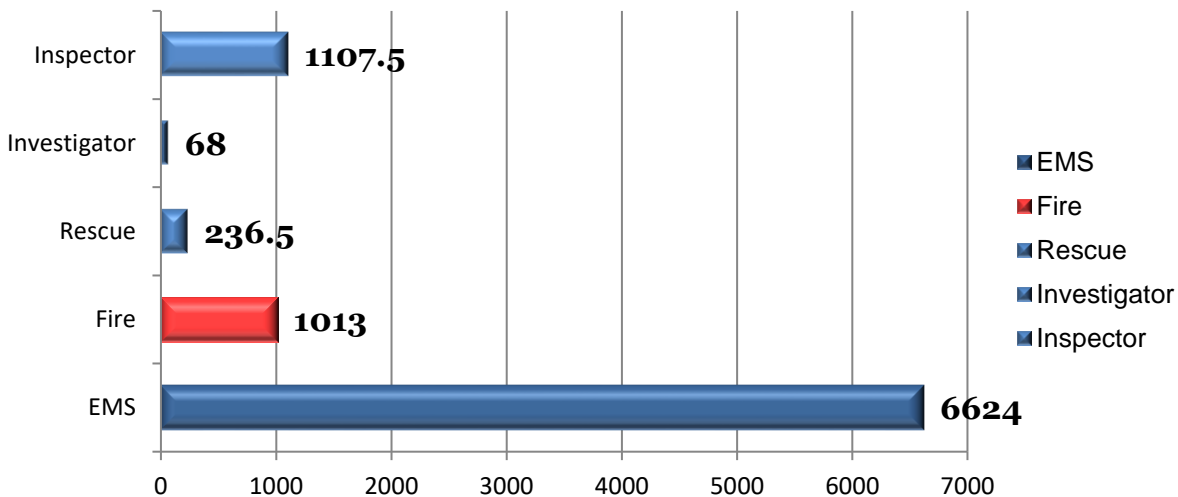


## Community Involvement

Sandusky Fire Department participated in many community activities throughout 2023, totaling 378 hours of non-emergent community involvement.

- Extinguisher training for many area businesses*
- Provided fire safety education for 770 area elementary school students*
- Spent 78 hours delivering Senior meals for OHGO*
- Provided fire safety instruction for Touch-A-Truck and Kidsfest*
- Provided hands only CPR instruction for Community Collaboration Day*
- Worked with Sandusky Police to coach Sandusky City Schools Elementary School flag football*
- Assisted Sandusky City Recreation Department deliver Safety Town to 60 soon to be kindergarteners*
- Provided ambulance coverage for 22 hours of area varsity football games*
- Assisted with food distribution at Fathers Heart church's food pantry*
- Coordinated The Erie County Fire Chiefs annual silent parade and firefighter memorial*
- Participated in Erie County's annual Memorial Day parade*
- Participated in The Sandusky Artisans Recovery Walk*
- Trained city staff in AED familiarization and CPR*
- Provided ambulance coverage during Sandusky City Schools 5k run*
- Delivered Santa Claus and The Easter Bunny to Washington Park and around city neighborhoods*
- Installed 216 smoke detectors in city residences*
- Participated in Sandusky Catholic Parishes annual Blue Mass*
- Logged 119 hours of Perkins and Sandusky High School student ride alongs*
- Conducted 125 hours of fireworks inspections at Cedar Point and other City fireworks displays*

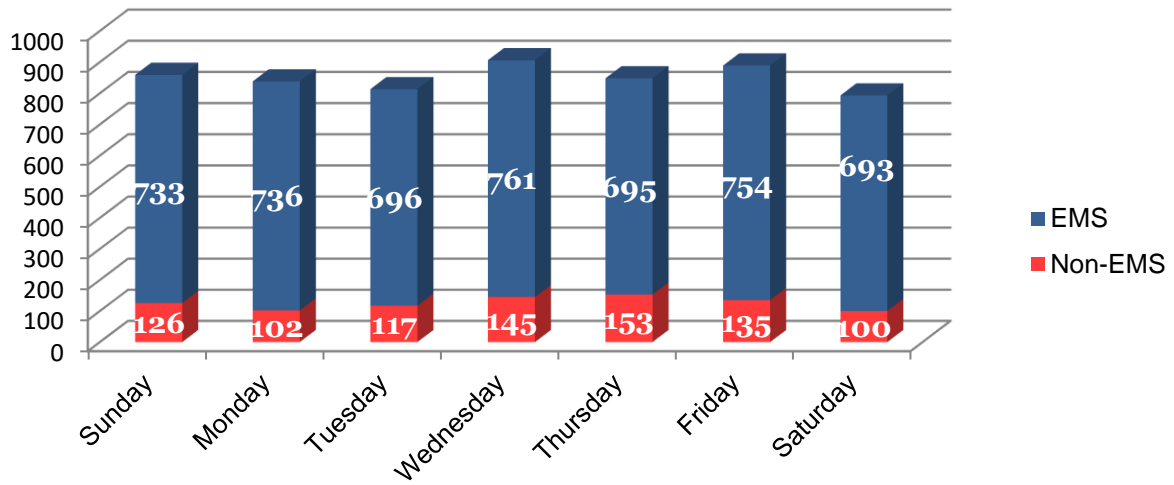
## Training Analysis

## Average Daily Staffing

The Sandusky Fire Department maintained a regularly scheduled average daily staffing level of 11.6 firefighters in 2023. Any drop in staffing level below 11 firefighters per day was supplemented with voluntary or mandatory overtime call-in of off-duty personnel.

## Mutual Aid

The Sandusky Fire Department provided mutual-aid 45 times. SFD also received automatic aid 20 times and mutual-aid 25 times in 2023 from other agencies within Erie County.
