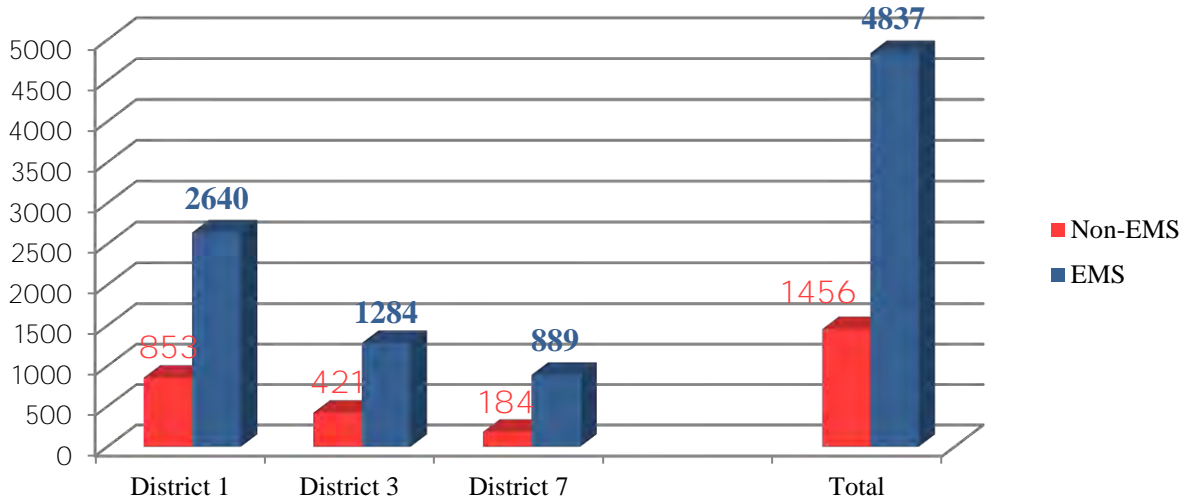

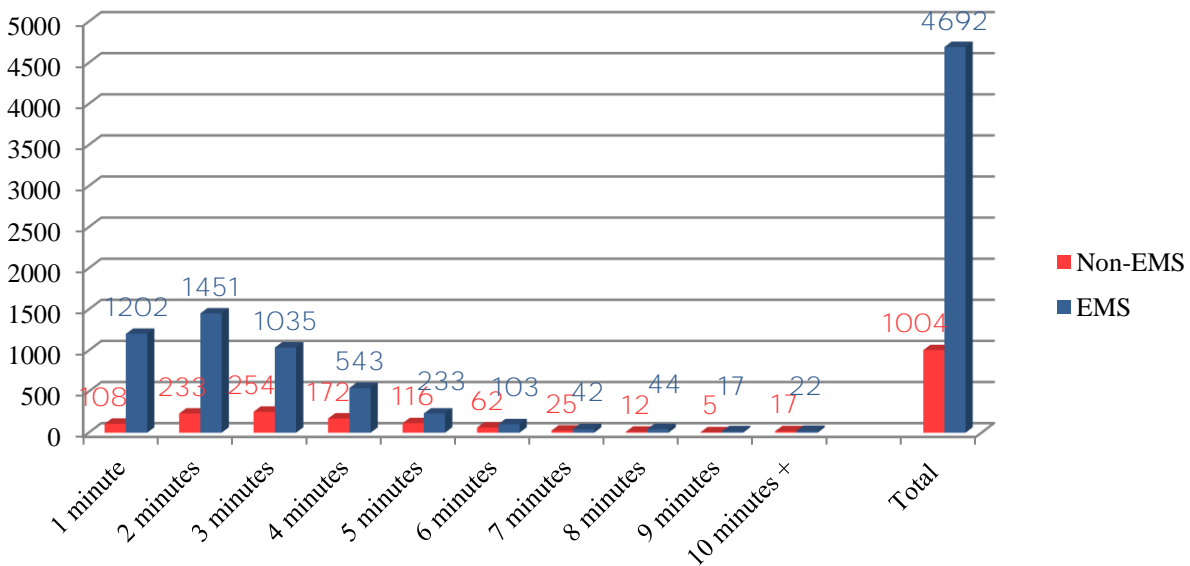


Operational Reports Generated For The Month



There were 6,293 reports generated in the year 2018. 56% of all reports were for District 1. Reports for District 3 and District 7 were 28% and 16% respectively.

District Emergency & Non-Emergency Response-To-Scene Statistics

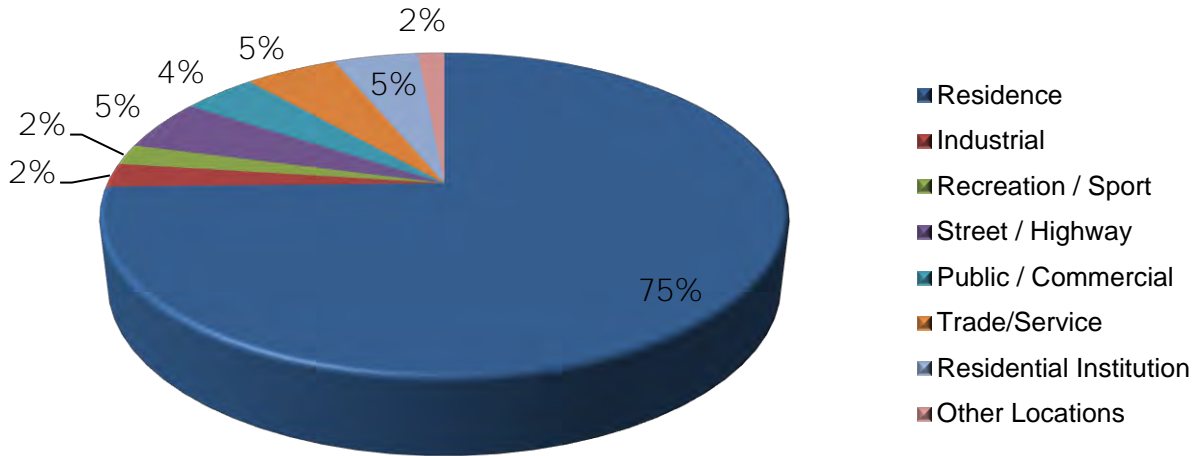


The average response-to-scene time for fire related calls was 3 minutes and 57 seconds. The average response time for EMS related calls was 3 minutes and 1 seconds.

The Sandusky Fire Department responded to 76% of fire related calls within 4 minutes and 90% of EMS related calls within 4 minutes. This averages out to 87% of all fire/ems related calls within 4 minutes in 2018.

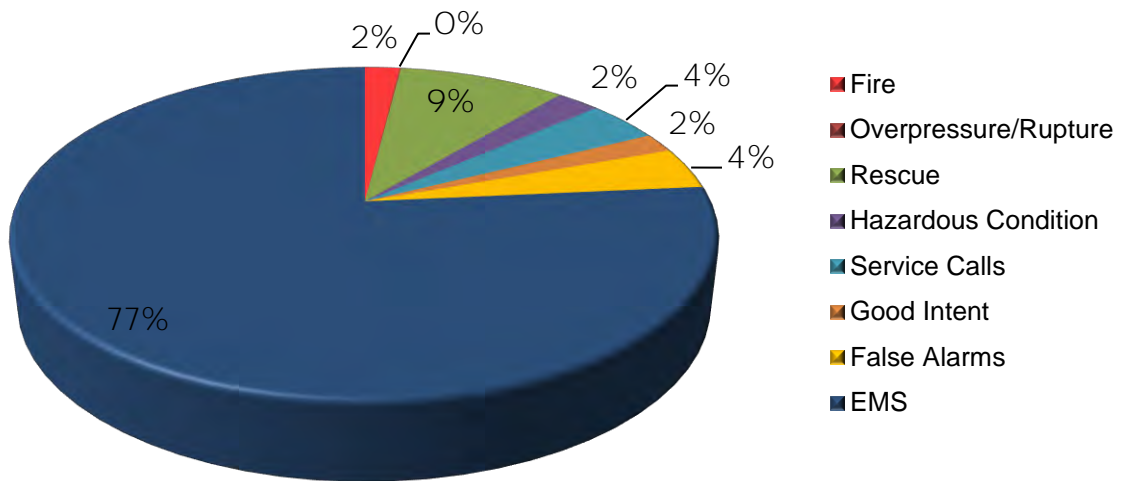


Response By Location



In 2018, 80% of all department responses were to residential occupancies (residences, nursing homes and residential institutions).

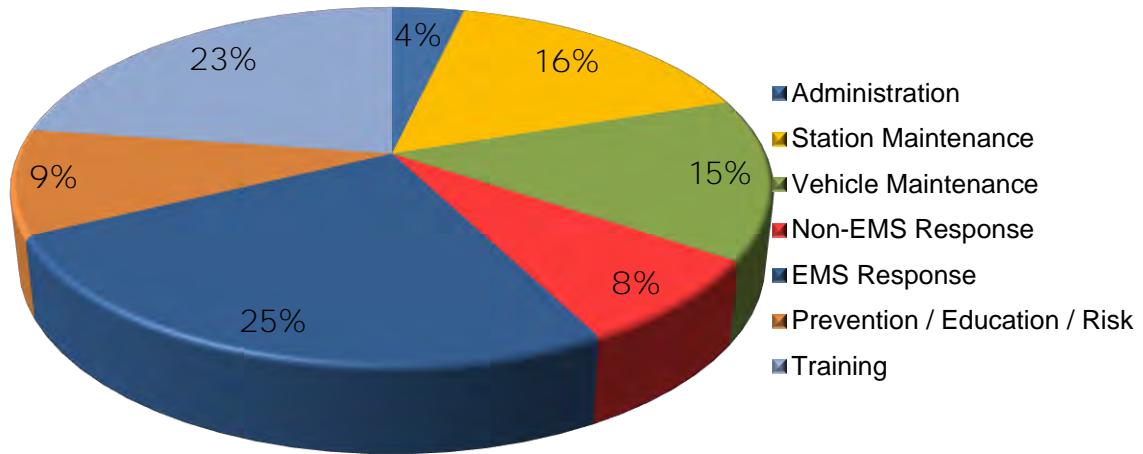
Incident Type



EMS related calls continue to be the highest requested service at 77%. There were 117 fires reported in 2018. 53 of which were structure fires. False alarms represented 4% of all emergent activity. There was an estimated \$980,835 in fire loss in the year 2018.

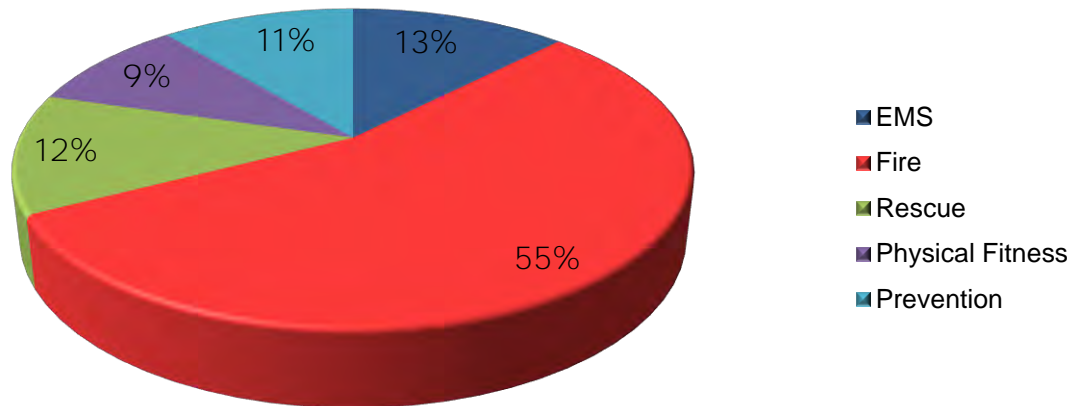


Annual Staff Activity



33% of all 2018 activity included fire/ems related calls. Station/Vehicle maintenance was 31% and training accounted for 23% of all staff activity.

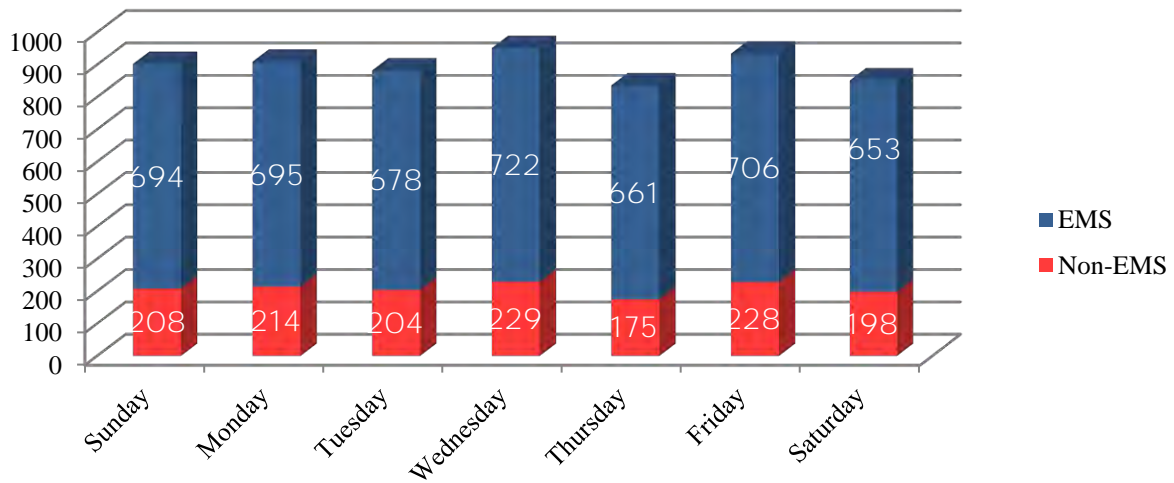
Training Analysis



Fire & EMS training comprised 68% in 2018. Physical fitness training comprised 9% of the total training hours. There were a total of 5,502 hours reported for the year.



Responses By Day-Of-Week For 2018



Average Daily Staffing:

The Sandusky Fire Department maintained a regularly scheduled average daily staffing level of 11.97 firefighters in the year 2018. Any drop in staffing level below 11 firefighters per day is supplemented with voluntary overtime call-in by off-duty personnel.

Mutual Aid:

The Sandusky Fire Department provided mutual-aid 30 times and received mutual-aid 29 times in the year of 2018 from other agencies within Erie County.
