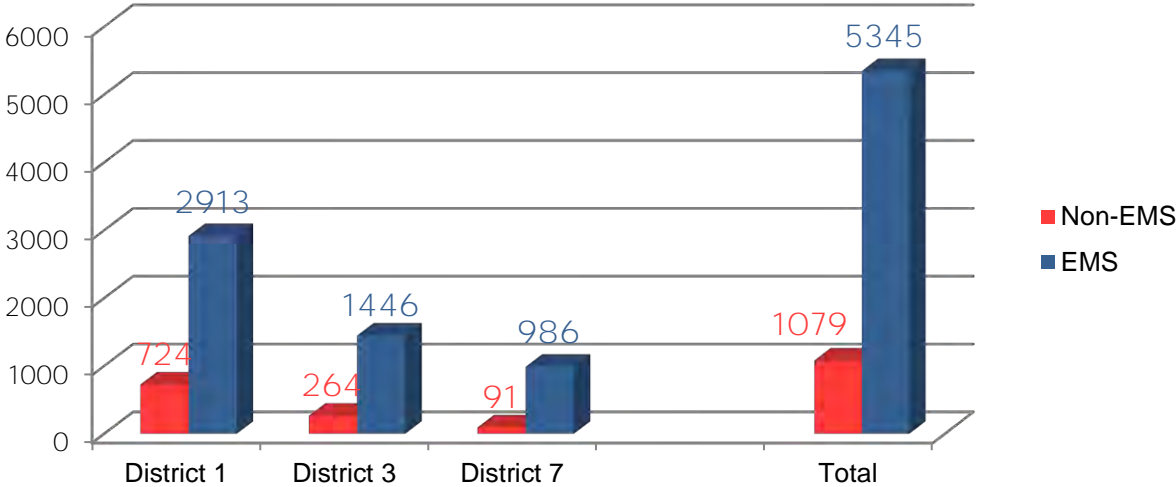

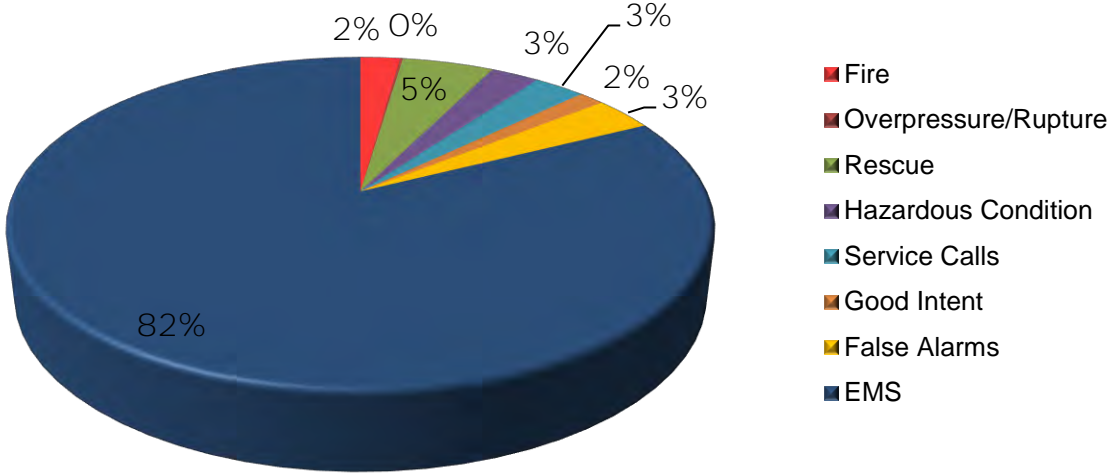


Operational Reports Generated For The Year



There were 6,424 reports generated in the year of 2019. 56.62% of all reports were for District 1. Reports for District 3 and District 7 were 26.62% and 16.77% respectively.

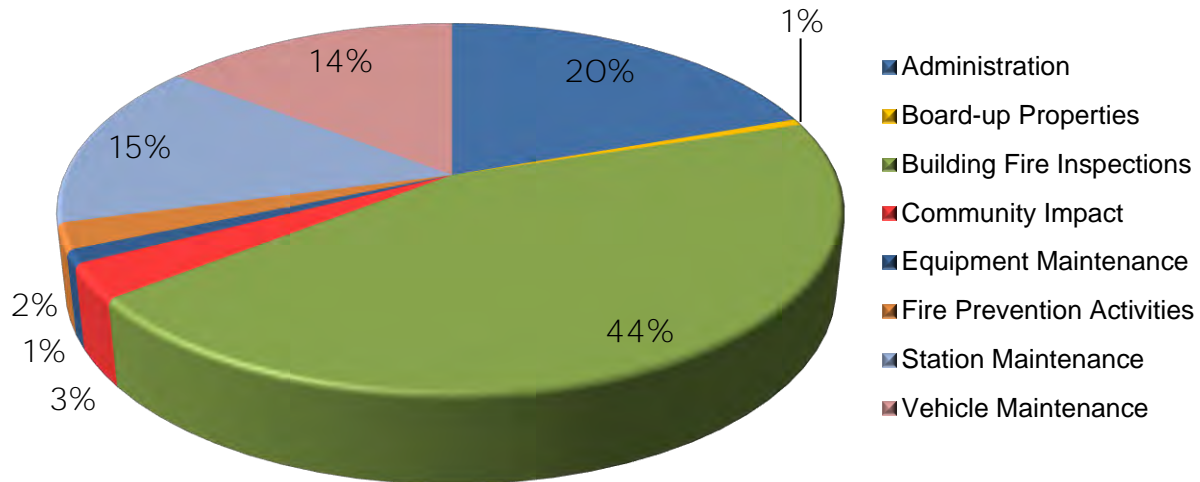
Incident Type



EMS related calls continue to be the highest requested service at 82%. There were 144 fires reported in 2019. False alarms represented 3% of all emergent activity. There was an estimated \$1,216,600.00 in fire loss in the year of 2019.

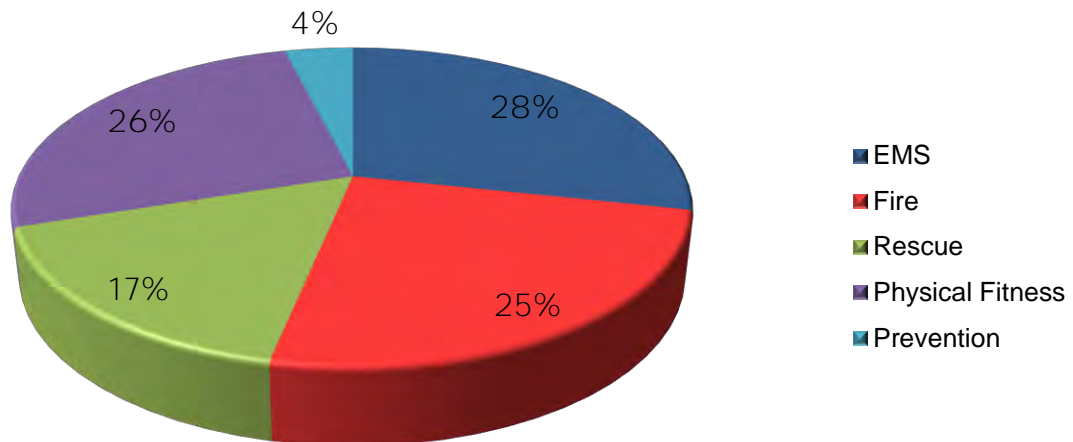


Annual Staff Activity

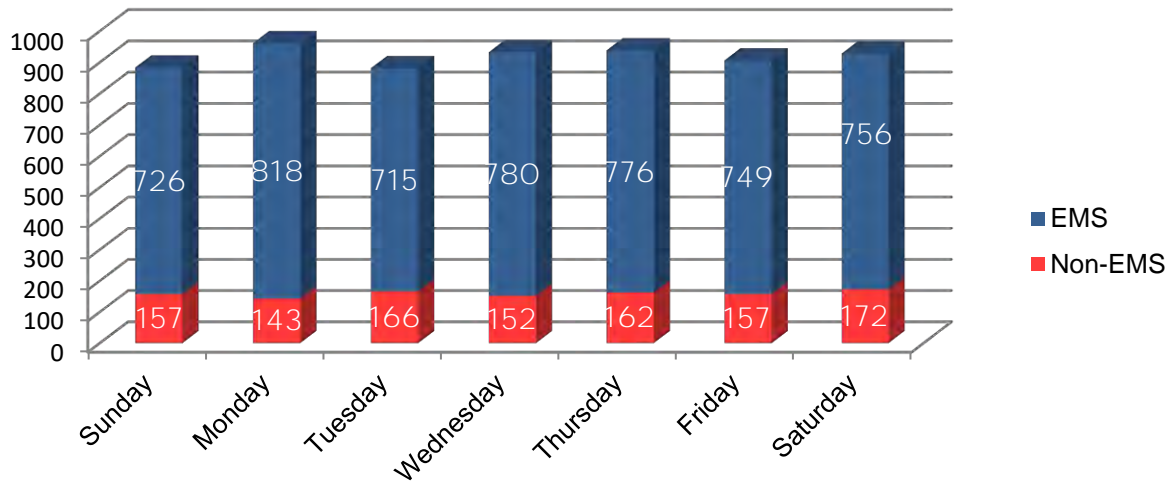
Training Analysis



Fire & EMS training comprised 53%. Physical fitness training comprised 26% of the total training hours.

Average Daily Staffing:

The Sandusky Fire Department maintained a regularly scheduled average daily staffing level of 11.32 firefighters in the year 2019. Any drop in staffing level below 11 firefighters per day is supplemented with voluntary overtime call-in by off-duty personnel.

Mutual Aid:

The Sandusky Fire Department provided mutual-aid 49 times. SFD also received automatic aid 29 times and mutual-aid 18 times in the year 2019 from other agencies within Erie County.
