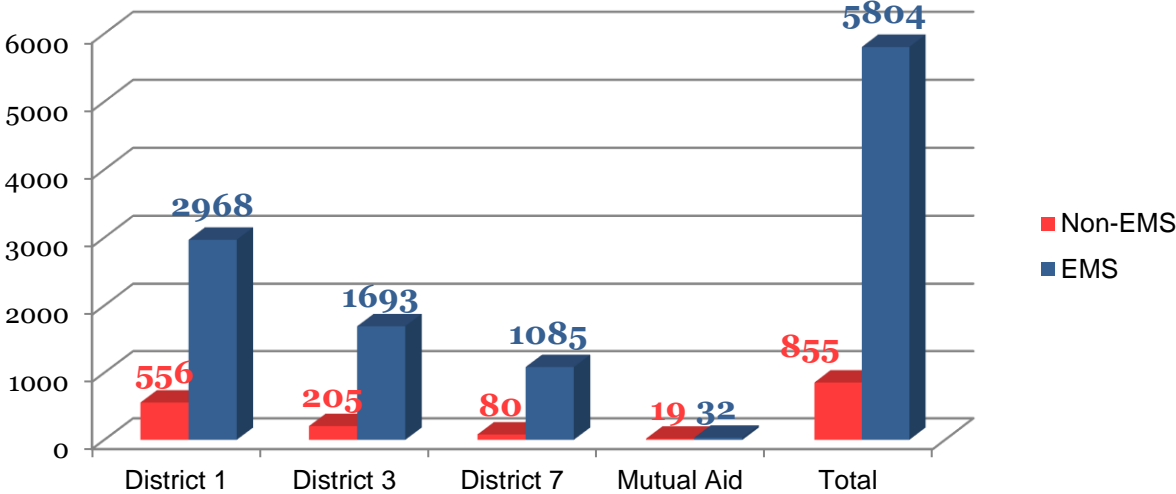

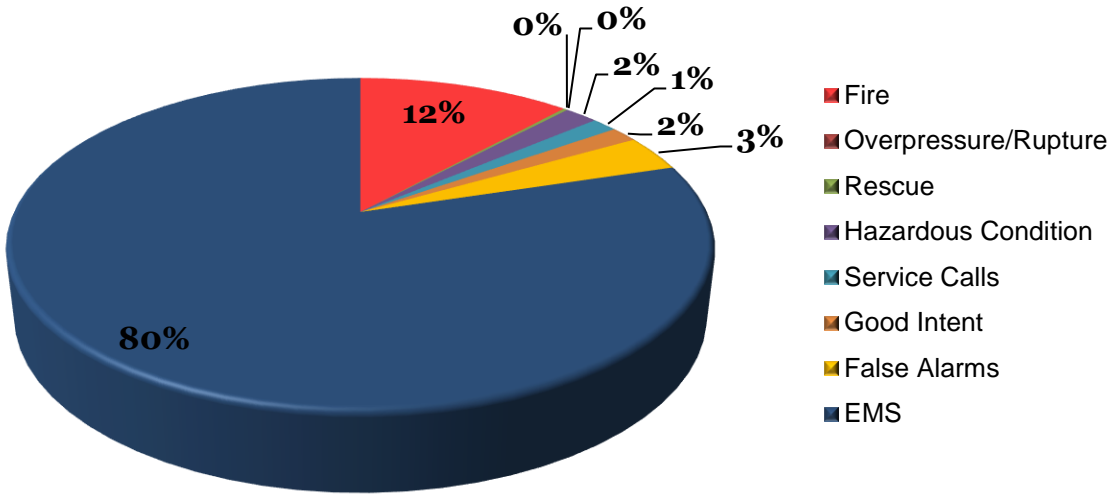


Operational Reports Generated For The Year



There were 6,659 reports generated in 2021. 51% of all reports were for District 1. Reports for District 3 and District 7 were 29% and 18% respectively. Mutual aid to other areas in Erie County accounted for less than 1% of all calls.

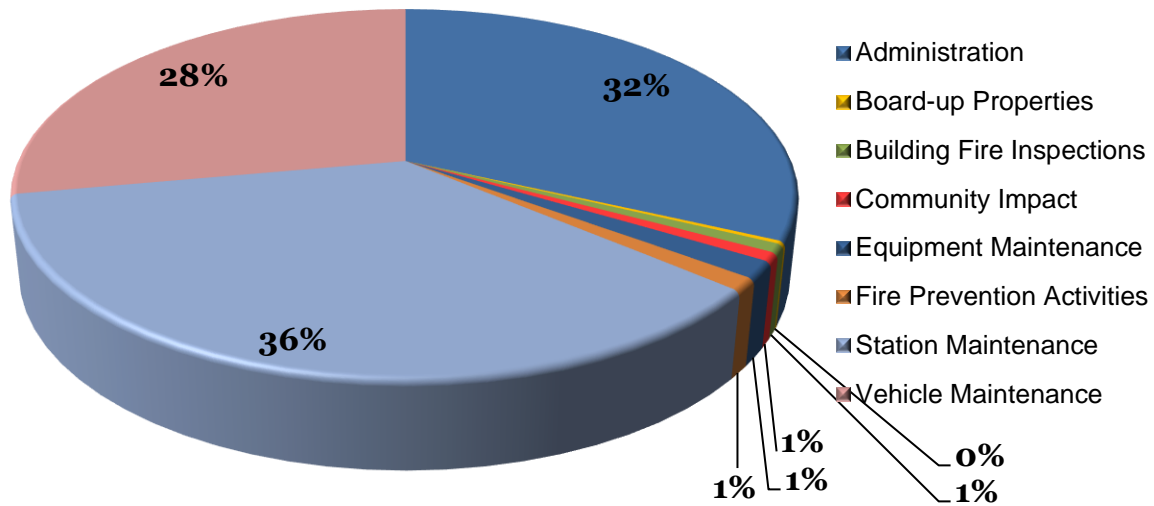
Incident Type



EMS related calls continue to be the highest requested service at 80%. There were 122 fires reported in 2021. False alarms represented 3.8% of all emergent activity. There was an estimated \$1,351,900.00 in fire loss in 2021.

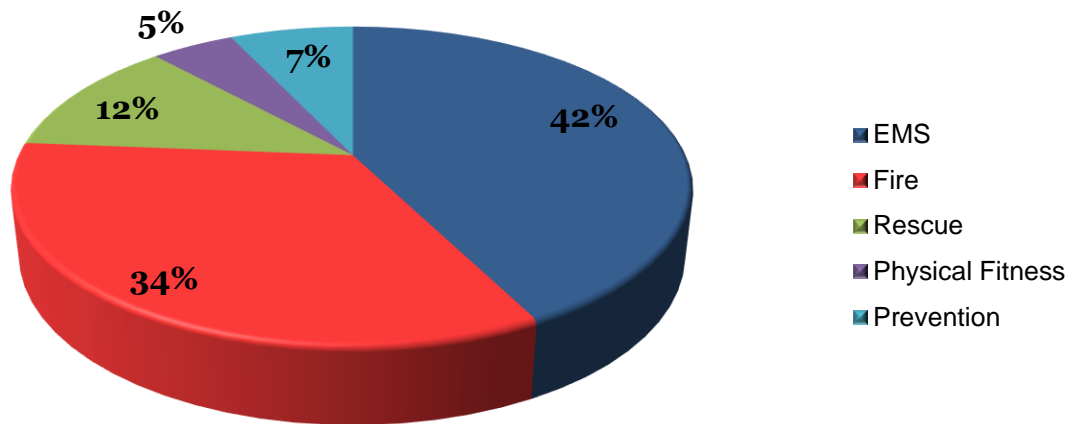


Annual Staff Activity



Sandusky Fire Department attended various Community Impact events in 2021. They made contact with many members of the community by assisting with various community functions.

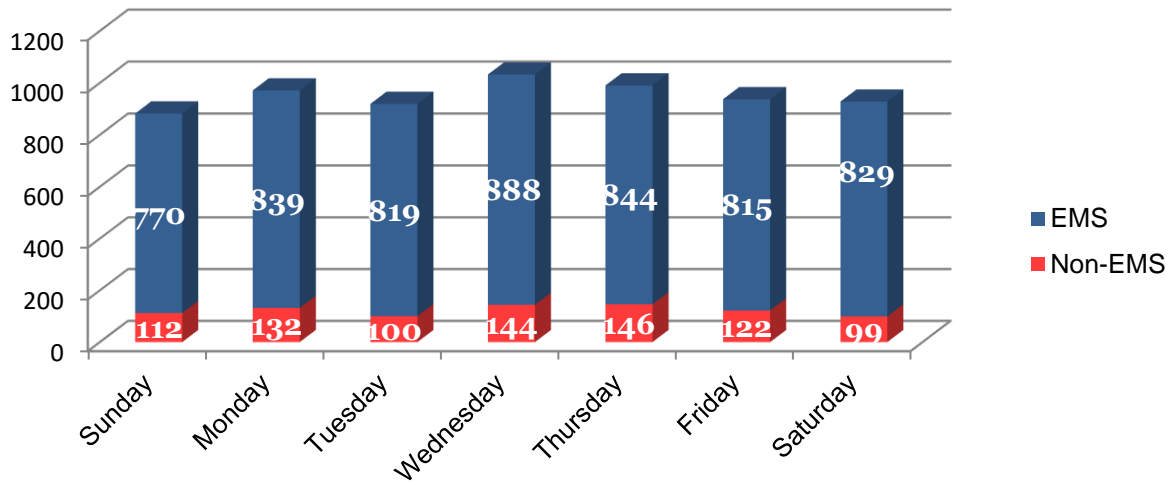
Training Analysis

Responses By Day-Of-Week



Average Daily Staffing:

The Sandusky Fire Department maintained a regularly scheduled average daily staffing level of 11.25 firefighters in 2021. Any drop in staffing level below 11 firefighters per day is supplemented with voluntary overtime call-in by off-duty personnel.

Mutual Aid:

The Sandusky Fire Department provided mutual-aid 67 times. SFD also received automatic aid 23 times and mutual-aid 22 times in 2021 from other agencies within Erie County.
