

#### Greeting Friends!

In 2016, the implementation of the Strategic Plan was the focus of our department. The police department fits into the livable city portion of the plan. The plan calls on the police department to have community policing strategies and initiatives. The goal of the plan and department is to "humanize the badge" and have our officers engaged in the community, for our citizens to see us on a more personal level. Although the department has been engaged in community policing for years, we focused more on all of our officers becoming "community policing" officers.

We implemented three strategies to accomplish this, with a perception and feel of our officers back to "walking the beat." We started business walks, neighborhood walks, and park walks, as a way to get out of the cruisers and offices, and connect to all of you. The first year was a success as a number of our positive interactions in the community were captured by citizens and shared by them or sent to us through social media, mainly Facebook. These interactions were positive encounters with children, citizens, or visitors in our community and the reach, reactions, and comments captured the importance of working together for the betterment of the community. Some of these interactions led to citizens sharing concerns with our officers on drug issues or alcohol issues and leads on crimes taking place in the neighborhood, where we were able to focus our efforts to curtailing these activities that affected their quality of life. We started the initiatives at the end of May and logged business walks (723), park walks (865), and neighborhood walks (751).

A launch of our Community Impact Officer (CIO) position started in 2015, with the funding created from the passage of Issue 8, was approved by the voters at the end of 2014. Officer Eric Costante was selected

to fill this critically important role. In 2016, we added an additional officer to this role, with officer Chris Rankins taking on the position. The CIO is similar to the Community Policing philosophies of the past, getting officers into the community.

Our department and officers continue to remain focused and cognizant on the relationship the police department has with the community. The 3<sup>rd</sup> annual National Night Out – Touch a Truck event was a huge success this year once again. In addition we've attended many community events, passing out trinkets such as the red, white and blue fiber optic lights to over 1,000 kids on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July, 1,500 Trick-or-Treat bags and a whole bunch of candy during Halloween, and 1,000 light up snowflake wands at the annual tree lighting. Our most popular and receptive giveaway was the 350 plush stuffed K9's that were distributed during the Christmas season. Community engagement and involvement has been and will be our focus, as we continue to serve and protect this community.

In 2017, the department will remain focused on how we can continue to positively impact the Bi-Centennial Strategic Plan, along with the new Neighborhood Initiative that is being rolled out for investment in six neighborhoods in the community. We look forward to partnering with our community business partners, citizens, and other city staff as we look forward to the cities Bi-Centennial celebration in 2018.




### SPD Staff Pie Chart









#### SPD Budget Pie Chart



### Traffic Enforcement Graph






### Written Warnings Pie Chart










#### Incident frequency by hour


