

Message from Chief John Orzech

Greeting Friends !

In 2018, it was a year of celebration of the City of Sandusky, commonly referred to as the City Bicentennial or Sandusky 2018. The events throughout the city were top notch and included many educational components that highlighted our rich heritage and diverse community.

Officers of the agency wore a special Bicentennial badge on their uniforms this year. The badge was a throwback style badge, featured on the front cover of this report.

We embarked on a total revision of our entire policy and procedure manual in April of this year. We met our goal of full implementation by the end of 2018. We partnered with a company named Lexipol, which provide services throughout the country and is specific to each state, such as Ohio. To those outside of law enforcement, it might seem as this isn't a big deal or topic. To law enforcement, the policies and procedures are what govern the operations of the agency, applying Federal, State, and Local laws and ordinances, along with case law and best practices. The policy section has 151 policies and an additional 75 Procedures. This project took hundreds of hours of reviews, additions, deletions, and much discussion to determine the best possible policies for our agency. Huge shout out and appreciation to Tammy Klingler, our project manager for Lexipol, who worked tirelessly to help us implement the policies and procedures.

Lexipol has provided proven defensible policies since being founded in 2003. Additionally, within the software, officers will be required to complete Daily Training Bulletins on existing policies in place that total about thirty a month. These bulletins are based on scenarios and how a scenario would be evaluated by the officers with the policy that is applicable to the scenario. Documentation will be available to depict that officers have acknowledged the policies and each time the policy is updated the officers must acknowledge the changes. The Daily Training Bulletins can be used as continuing education credits through the State of Ohio.

A site has been selected for the future home of the "Justice Center", which will house the Sandusky Municipal Court and Sandusky Police Department Operations. The site selected is the American Crayon site, on the corner of Rockwell St. and Hayes Ave. An architect firm will be hired in early 2019 and an anticipated completion date in 2021.

The department continued to focus on our Bicentennial Strategic Plan objectives of providing a safe community, with community policing efforts by all members of the department. We understand the importance of police-citizen interaction being paramount to our success. The police department can't be successful, without the community supporting us with their eyes and ears. We continued to pursue opportunities to incorporate officers at many events throughout the community and humanize themselves as often as possible.




2018 SPD Staff Pie Chart







2018 SPD Budget Pie Chart












2018 SPD Revenue Chart











2018 Traffic Enforcement Graph










2018 SPD Written Warnings Pie Chart







2018 SPD Criminal Arrest Graph












2018 SPD Incident Frequency By Hour / Day








