**PRESENT:**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 A.M. by Acting Chair Mark Harrington.

**MINUTES OF THE  
PREVIOUS MEETING:**

The minutes of the June 7, 2018 meeting were approved upon a Motion by Mr. Warner, seconded by Mr. Zuilhof. Motion carried.

**STAFF UPDATE**

Director of Neighborhood Planning and Development Angie Byington reported that the City had applied for a grant from the US Government for a total of \$18.5 Million for paving and repaving. The City is hopeful that a grant will be awarded for \$13.9 Million with the City's share \$4.6 Million. The award will be made by the end of 2018.

Director Aaron Kline reported that Sandusky Bay Initiative is coming to an end with funding only through the end of June 2018. Pilot project were developed to be utilized all around the great lakes. Many of these projects had to do with open lake disposal issues. fMr. Kline has agreed to make a presentation of these projects on our next meeting on August 2, 2018 at 7:30 AM.

Lance Warner inquired of Ms. Byington about the neighborhood projects. It was suggestd that Talon

Flohr will also provide a presentation on August 2, 2018 of the progress in this area.

Mrs. Corso inquired about the Cove area and the improvements being done. Ms. Byington reported that all that was being done is a cleanup and some new signage the scope of which reflects what the neighborhood wanted. Mrs. Corso asked that Mr. Kline look into the unsightly weeds.

Mr. Miller inquired about the SID districts and the taxes proposed to fund the cleanup crews. Ms. Byington reported that it was voted down by the City Commission. It was suggested that recruiting some of the stakeholders and explaining the proposal more completely might help the next time around.

Mr. Miller reported that the Kiwanis Park baseball backstop was being erected as we met and that the new picnic shelter will be dedicated on August 1, 2018 at noon.

Ms. Byington also reported that the Public Art Master Plan will be discussed on August 1, 2018 at Washington Park.

**ADJOURNMENT:**

There being no further business to come before the Bayfront Corridor Committee, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Mr. Warner, seconded by Mrs. Corso at 8:02 A.M.
