STAFF UPDATE:

Ms. Byington reported that the final design for the Shoreline Drive had been approved and construction will begin in May. A photometrics review for lighting will be done to see what savings can be realized. Mile Marker -0- will be installed for the starting point for the Sandusky Bay Pathway south of the Schade Mylander Plaza.

Jackson Street Pier final design includes a request for a flood plane variance for the proposed structure . the Board of Zoning Appeals tabled the variance request for more design work and Engineering is working on that. All structures are still in preliminary design phase.

Downtown parking enforcement will be starting in May 6, 2019 . The issue was discussed with the Committee members including ongoing construction issues, the need to highlight alternative parking besides on street parking and encouraging merchants to have their employees park in designated lots.

A member requested information about the City Building construction and Bike Week impact on parking.

There is a possible revision to the site plan for the Keller Building, which will be presented to the committee.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Committee inquired about the identity of the City Commission liaison for the Bayfront Corridor Committee.

NEW BUSINESS:

There was no new business.

COMMUNITY INPUT:

Dave Miller advised that the Kiwanis Club had again organized a shoreline cleanup to be done on May 18.

There being no further business to come before the Bayfront Corridor Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 8:04 AM upon motion by Mr. Hayberger, joined by Mr. Zuilhof.
