PREVIOUS MEETING:**

Upon Motion by Mark Harrington, seconded by David Miller the minutes for the meeting of June 6, 2019 were approved as submitted.

STAFF UPDATE:

Mr. Voltz reported that the Shoreline Drive project is well underway. The work consisted of excavating the roadway, which has exposed the old railroad tracks and prepared the base for sub-base repairs and utility installation on the south side of the road. the southside of the roadway is

closed and open to traffic on the northside headed west bound only.

Jackson Street pier construction is has also begun and after the delays due to the weather and high water there is no real timeline.

The Keller Building is also moving forward and it is now projected that there will be 13 units with a smaller square footage when the number of units was projected to be 6-8.

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no old business.

NEW BUSINESS:

Comments were received about the new meeting space for the City Commission in the new building. Dave Miller inquired about the progress on the justice center and was told that there was nothing new to report.

COMMUNITY INPUT:

Mr. Schwanger inquired about the number of Shoreline Drive tie ins to power, and it was not yet known how many there would be. Mr. Schwanger also inquired if the north side sidewalks would be removed or preserved, and they are to be replaced.

There being no further business to come before the Bayfront Corridor Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 7:42 AM upon motion by Mr. Harrington, joined by Mr. Miller.
