In the first activity, members were asked to consider two questions while brainstorming the commission's 2022 work plan in order to align it with the strategic objectives of the city: 1) What public art will ensure Sandusky is vibrant, celebrated, connected, and livable? And 2) How can the arts commission help make it happen? A timer was set and each member wrote as many ideas as possible, one per page of sticky note. Next, each member read all their ideas to the group and Arin placed them on a poster board. Ideas that were the same or very similar were grouped together.



Adjournment:


Upon a motion by Brian and a second by Robin, the meeting adjourned at 6:29pm.
