2. **Old Business**
 - a. **Park improvements:**
 - i. Central Park – new equipment is almost completely installed.
 - ii. Huron Park – A community meeting to determine the design of Huron Park will be held on 6/18. 1:00 PM with the Summer Parks Program participants and with the community at 5:30 PM at the Greenhouse. Invites were mailed out to the neighborhoods.
 - iii. Tom McKenna talked about the amount of trash in the parks if we could come up with some solution to help combat the litter problem.
 - b. **Mills** – Irrigation system has pressure issues. Need to test the lines. Toro company will be out Thursday or Friday to test and diagnose problem.
 - c. **T-Ball/Coach Pitch**- Finished yesterday a lot of positive feedback with the 2 leagues.
 - d. **Summer Camps**- Registrations are a bit slower due to the fun guide being delayed. Looking forward to a good summer.
 - e. **Summer Playground Program**- The three parks being utilized this Huron, Farwell & Foxborough. Program will be Monday -Friday 10:00-2:00 PM. Salvation Army providing lunch delivered by the fire department. Training for staff will be June 13 & 14, they will receive CPR, First Aid Training, Trauma Informed Care, Lindsay Law and Concussion Training.
 - f. **Bayfront Bazaar & Brew**- First one will be held tonight. Working with North Coast Young Professionals on this event. Next one July 11.
 - g. **Downtown Ice Rink**- the cost to rent would be \$150,000. For a 6-week period. After much discussion board was not sure that this was a wise investment.
 - h. **Fun Guide** – The summer fun guide will be mailed to all 44870 residents later this week. We used a big push with Social Media, and sending out a flyer of all camps offered to the Sandusky Schools before school ended. We are considering doing this for SCCS and Perkins in the future.
