Members and staff discussed storm clean-up on W. Monroe, which was hit badly by a storm in mid-July. Many of the removals are due to storm damage during the 2022 Spring season. Commissioner Waddington questioned whether there are any current, local issues with diseased trees and Nate indicated that the two invasive pests he has been alerted of more recently are the spotted lantern fly. It has entered Ohio but is not yet a problem, but is hitting Maples, what's left of the Ash, grape vines and tree of heavens. Additionally, the Asian longhorn beetle is present in southern Ohio.
