**APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Jordan Sternberg made motion, second by Robin Lloyd to approve minutes from 05.16.23. No objections, Motion carried.**

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Vinyl Mural Project Update:** Arin commented that two more of the murals have been installed at 231 W. Market Street and 121 Jackson Street. The 6 are installed and this project is complete. People have stated they do not realize that they are vinyl applications.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

**Artist Led Grant Proposal:** Derek Brennan has submitted a proposal for a mural to be applied to the north façade (back) of 303 East Washington Street. It is expected to be completed within the next 1-2 months and will be Sandusky's largest outdoor mural to date. The artwork theme is Sandusky Warbler Migration & Local Wildflowers. The artist, Derek Brennan, has completed murals across Ohio and in Sandusky including the Live Green mural on West Washington Street at A&B Hobbies & Cycles and multiple murals to the interior of the Marketplace and Hogrefe building. The total cost for the mural is \$15,000, \$6500 from the building owner, requesting \$8500 from the Public Art commission. There is only \$7500 left in the Artist Led Grant for this year's workplan. Staff are recommending this commission support the grant for \$7500 which would conclude this year's grant funding for this year. The artist stated the mural application would take approximately a month to complete. The artwork is expected to last twenty years. **Cable Steinemann made motion, with a second by Marsha Carrington, to proceed with this proposal as presented. Roll call – all. President Stanley declared the motion passed.**

**Artbox Proposal:** Lori Jameson has submitted an Artbox proposal to paint the Lake Erie Monster. Public Works has been working to help identify a location for this proposal. The City has approximately sixty electric boxes, the majority being the smaller boxes. This proposal would need a large box, one on Hayes Avenue and Tyler Street has been approved. Discussion that one near the water may be more appropriate, but not many large ones near the water are City boxes. **Marsha Carrington made motion, with a second by Robin Lloyd to approve the Artbox mural at that location. Roll call – all. President Stanley declared the motion passed.**

**Artist Led Grant Program:** Arin has had several calls about this program after seeing the Farmers

Market. One was for an event and another for a mural. Arin advised them to bring the ideas to this commission early next year for consideration.
