APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Robin Lloyd made motion, second by Shawn Daley to approve minutes from 05.17.22. Being no objections, Motion carried.

CURRENT BUSINESS

Art Box Program Draft:

Arin Blair shared an updated Draft of the program. The City's traffic control boxes will be the boxes painted. The applicant can specify which box they would like to paint (there are 40 boxes), unless the Art Commission has a preferred location, the location will not be guaranteed. Changes to the selection criteria include: is the questionnaire complete – the Committee will reach out to artist's who need to further complete the application for review also does the Committee rate a local artist higher rather than a regional one. The focus was to keep the application more broad to increase beginner artist completion. The application will be posted on the Public Arts page of the City Website, an artist email list, and a Facebook post to spread the word. The application does not list a deadline, just that the applications will be accepted until all 6 project boxes are awarded. Each proposal will be given a 10-business day timeline to insure completion. **Shawn Daley made motion, second by Robin Lloyd to move forward with the Draft to call for artists. Vote – Motion carried.**

Vinyl Mural Program Draft:

The artist may indicate their preferred location, but the Art Commission will delegate the locations with building owner approval. The Commission will seek bids from qualified sign producers once the murals have been selected. The budget for this program is \$25,000. The building owners have approved eight potential locations. The art does not have to be about Sandusky. An artist can submit more than one piece for selection. Artists will give a bio and list past experience, and if the artwork is on display elsewhere. The artists are not paid for the artwork for the mural. The murals should last 3-5 years or more. A map will be made showing where the locations are, as is Lange Trust for their hanging sculptures display. **Robin Lloyd made motion, second by Adam Ramsdell to move forward with the Draft to call for artists. Vote – Motion carried.**
