Minutes:

Upon a motion of Adam Ramsdell and a second of Shawn Daley, the minutes of the June 15, 2021 meeting were approved. All voting members were in favor of the motion and the motion was approved.

Current Business:

- New Chief Planner Arin Blair introduced herself to the commission.
- Sandusky City Hall Gallery
McKenzie stated that her and Arin measured the space where the selected pieces are going to be placed and there is ample space. She then showed the committee the 18 pieces that were selected. She said that the supplies needed to hang the pieces have been ordered and she is expecting for the supplies to arrive within 7-10 days. Staff can hang the pieces, but McKenzie said she would like to get some help from committee members that may have experience with hanging displays. Cable Steinemann made a motion to accept the recommendation of the Selection Committee and Adam Ramsdell seconded. All voting members were in favor of the motion.
- Columbus Avenue Streetscape
Arin stated that she is hoping the design process can begin in the fall and that she is thinking there will be a steering committee involved. She said she will update the Public Arts and Culture Committee as she can and make sure they are involved.
- Hanging Sculptures by Jerzy Jotka Kedziora
McKenzie said that Sarah Prout, with the Lange Trust said that she has not yet received word that the artist can come from Poland. After that is figured out then they will work on a timeline.

Old Business:

- Sticker on the Wayne Street Transit Bus Shelter is peeling off. Arin stated that the Public Works Department has been asked to remove the stickers that are peeling off. She said that she could look into what the cost of reprinting those would be and let the committee know to see if they would like to get them reprinted.

New Business:

- Marsha stated that she has a show coming up if anyone is able to make it.
- Robin explained that on June 26th during Sandusky Pride, City Commission President Dick

Brady and City Manager Eric Wobser declared Sandusky the birthplace of marriage equality. She said that she thinks the Public Art & Culture Commission should consider doing a future project related to this.

- McKenzie stated that this would be her last week with the City as she took a new job.
