

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017-35**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JUAN BAUTISTA ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE AND REHABILITATION FUNDING**

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 recently adopted the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the act will provide road funding for repair and improvements through a new 0.12 cent per gallon gas tax and 0.20 cent per gallon diesel tax; and

**WHEREAS**, the legislation requires agencies to prepare a list of potential projects with a description, location, estimated cost, estimated date of completion, and useful life analysis for each project; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding available for the City of San Juan Bautista in Fiscal Year 2017-2018 (FY 17-18), once the project list is submitted and approved, is \$10,520; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to submit the list of potential projects and receive funding, the City is required to demonstrate that the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) funds are included in the FY 17-18 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the RMRA funds were not included in the FY 17-18 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds can be added to the FY 17-18 budget through a supplemental budget appropriation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of San Juan Bautista hereby adopts a supplemental budget appropriation including \$10,520 of revenue from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) in the Special Revenues Fund: Gasoline Tax and Transportation Revenue Fund, for the Muckelemi Street reconstruction project.
