



FOR COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION R314 AND R315 OF THE 2019 RESIDENTIAL CODE

Smoke alarms are required to be installed in single family or multifamily dwelling units when the valuation of a permit exceeds \$1,000.00. Carbon monoxide alarms are required to be installed in a single family or multifamily dwelling unit(s) anytime a permit is obtained. As per sections R314 and R315 of the 2019 California Residential Code, Smoke and Carbon monoxide alarms are required to be installed in the following locations:

Smoke Alarms:

1. Outside of each **separate** dwelling sleeping unit in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms.
2. On each additional story of a dwelling, including basements and habitable attics.
3. Within each sleeping room or potential sleeping room.
4. Smoke alarms shall be installed not **less** than 3 feet horizontally from a door or opening of a bathroom that contains a bathtub or shower unless otherwise infeasible.

Carbon Monoxide Alarms:

1. Outside of each **separate** dwelling sleeping unit in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms.
2. One on every occupiable level of a dwelling unit, including basements level of a dwelling unit
3. Where a fuel burning appliance is located within a bedroom or it's attached room, the alarm shall be installed in the bedroom.
