2021-07-27	Received call from Mayor Jordan requesting assistance in assisting a female identified as Stephanie who was without shelter. I contacted the appropriate agency (Community Homeless Solutions) and spoke with Charles Felipe who requested I access Stephanie for any visible signs/symptoms of COVID and asked if she would be willing to be tested? I observed Stephanie to be clear eyed, no runny nose and she informed me does not have a fever and would gladly take a COVID test. Stephanie was provided a face covering by Sherie from the Water Store and I also wore a mask. I transported Stephanie in the City Ford Explorer in the right side rear passenger seat with all windows partially down to circulate the air. I notified NETCOM of my starting mileage from the intersection of Fourth and Pearce. I took a slight detour to the area to the rear of Dona Esther's for approximately 5 minutes to allow Stephanie to gather up her personal belongs. Upon Stephanie loading her belonging and returning to the back seat of the Explorer, we proceeded to the Community Homeless Solutions agency located at 1161 San Felipe Road in Hollister. Upon arrival I dropped Stephanie off and provided	Rich Brown

NETCOM with my ending mileage and returned to San Juan. Upon return to the office I decontaminated the Ford Explorer with Lysol disinfectant and let stand for 1 hour before wiping down.
