Books & Materials: We are still chipping away at the \$4,000 grant from the State Library for a Zip books program that must be spent by June 30, 2022. As of May 31, we have spent roughly \$1,900. Any amount we are unable to spend by June 30 has to be returned to the CA State Library. Since the books are covered by this program some of the remaining City budget for FY22 will be spent on DVD and Blu-rays.

Outreach: In person Utility Assistance is available **on select days** through mid-June. (**June 2 & 9**). After that residents can contact the Workforce Development Office for assistance. There is still funding that is specific to San Juan Bautista. The application is easy and the turn around time is fairly quick so please encourage people to either contact the Library or San Benito Community Services. Our next “big” event is Saturday June 11, 2022 from 10 am – 3 pm with the State of California as part of their “Vaccinate ALL 58” program. The clinic includes a free meal from Tacos Rafus "in a box" to comply with the Food Truck ordinance. We are awaiting word on whether our grant was approved for staffing and performers. Our first clinic on May 21 was a success, in my opinion, with more than 30 doses administered (including boosters for Library staff!).

MOBAC/PLP: I attended the annual PLP meeting via Zoom on May 13. It was a very quick meeting. The main order of business was to approve the OCLC pricing for FY23. I abstained from voting on that item since we do not participate in OCLC. The motion did pass. I gave an extremely abridged recap of our activities over the past year similar to what can be found in these status reports. There were no MOBAC meetings.
