### OCTOBER MONTHLY REPORT 2023

Activities during the month of October experienced a decrease of animal control cases compared to September. There were three (3) cases. One case involved a dog biting a family member, the other dog case involved the attempt to surrender a dog and the third case involved an injured pigeon. The first dog was quarantined and showed no signs of illness at the conclusion of the quarantined period. The owner of the second dog case was referred to several agencies for assistance and a follow up called was not returned to determine the status of this case. The pigeon was placed in a large cage, received fresh food and water and after three days was released. There was one noise complaint received and was determined to be unfounded. I started an on-line course for animal control certification.

Kysmet Officers did not issue any parking citations or green stickers. I issued 2 green tags, 3 parking citations, and 0 Administrative Citations. Kysmet discovered one unlocked business. Kysmet's focus for the month of November will continue to be patrol activities especially during the Thanksgiving Holidays and parking enforcement.

Code Enforcement will focus on completing the issuance of the informational letter pertaining to cul-de-sac parking (Copy attached) and parking enforcement.

The trapper continues to remove the feral chickens and roosters.

RE: Cul-de-sac Parking

Dear Name,

In an effort to avoid having to issue parking citations in your cul-de-sac, for the violation of parking on a sidewalk, parking in front of a driveway, and parallel parking, the City is providing you with copies of the applicable ordinance sections for your review as follows:

In accordance with Section 7-4-106: Parking in front of driveways.

It shall be unlawful for the operator of a vehicle to stop, park or leave standing said vehicle in front of a public or private driveway, whether attended or unattended, except that a bus engaged as a common carrier, school bus, or a taxicab may stop in front of a public or private driveway to load or unload passengers.

# In accordance with Section 7-4-107: Parking on sidewalks.

It shall be unlawful for any person to stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, on any portion of a sidewalk, or with the body of said vehicle extending over a portion of a sidewalk, except for (A) electric carts operated by physically disabled persons, (B) electric carts operated by persons fifty (50) years of age or older, or (C) while in the course of their employments electric carts operated by employees of the United States Postal Service, State and local government, utility companies, on public sidewalks. Disabled persons and persons fifty (50) years or age or older, in order to qualify for their exceptions hereunder, shall apply for and obtain from the City Manager a permit to operate on and over sidewalks, and an identification sticker. Such permits and stickers shall become void once and if the permit holder ceases to operate, own or lease the cart.

It shall be noted that living at the residence where the driveway or portion of sidewalk that is in violation does not exempt the operator/owner of the vehicle from receiving a parking citation for the violation.

# In accordance with Section 7-4-115A: Parking parallel with curb.

Except as otherwise provided, every vehicle stopped or parked upon a roadway where there are adjacent curbs shall be stopped or parked with the right-hand wheels of such vehicle parallel with and within eighteen inches (18") of the right-hand curb, except that motorcycles shall be parked with at least one (1) wheel or fender touching the right-hand curb. Where no curbs or barriers bound any two (2) way roadway, right hand parallel parking is required unless otherwise indicated.
