TO: All Interested Agencies, Groups and Persons:

On or about November 21, 2022, San Miguel County, New Mexico will request the Local Government Division, Department of Finance and Administration (LGD/DFA) of the State of New Mexico to remove the environmental conditions and to release Small Cities Funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383) for the following project.

New Mexico CDBG Project # 21-C-RS-I-01-G-50

Brief Project Description: San Miguel County will install approximately 402 linear feet of 2-inch PVC waterline with associated appurtenances on State Road 223, various engineering/construction management related costs and CDBG grant administration expenses.

Name of Grantee: San Miguel County, NM

CDBG Grant Amount: \$200,000

An Environmental Review Record for the proposed project has been made by the County of San Miguel, NM that documents the environmental review of the project. The Environmental Review Record is on file at the above address and is available for public examination and copying upon request.


Public Comments on Findings

All interested agencies, groups and persons, disagreeing with this decision are invited to submit written comments for consideration by the County to the address as set forth above. Such written comments must be received at the addressed specified within seven (7) days after this publication or within ten (10) days if the notice is posted and mailed. All such comments so received will be considered and the County will not request the release of funds or take administrative action on the project prior to the date specified in the proceeding sentence.

Release of Funds

The County of San Miguel, NM will undertake the activities described above with Community Development Block Grant funds under Title I from its Program Year 2022 under grant numbered 21-C-RS-I-01-G-50 from the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. The County of San Miguel, NM is certifying to LGD and HUD that Mr. Harold M. Garcia in his official capacity as Commission Chairman, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews, decision-making and action; and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval, the County of San Miguel, NM may use the Block Grant funds and it will have satisfied its responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969. LGD will accept an objection to its approval only on one or more of the bases and the procedures described in 24 CFR Part 58.75. Objections are to be addressed to the LGD/DFA, Bataan Memorial Building, Suite 202, Santa Fe, NM 87502.

Objections to the release of funds on bases other than those stated above will not be considered by the LGD/DFA. No objections received later than twenty-five (25) days after this publication will be considered by LGD.
